Prayers for the Lighting of the  
 Advent Wreath  
 Week Two

*Dear Jesus, you entered our world on Christmas as the Prince of Peace. This Advent, as we strive to become the-best-version-of-ourselves, fill us with a deep and abiding peace. Help us share that peace with everyone we encounter, especially those who need it most. Amen*

**Walk With One:** Augustus Tolton was born into slavery to Catholic parents. Shortly after the American Civil War broke out, he escaped with his mom into Illinois. After facing harsh prejudice at a Catholic school in Quincy, Augustus was welcomed by Fr. Peter McGirr to his parish's school, where he ensured Augustus received a Catholic education. He later opened the first Catholic school for black children in Quincy.

Augustus was accepted into seminary in Rome after being refused admittance into seminary in America. He was ordained a deacon in 1885, and assumed he would be sent to Africa after being ordained a priest. However, Giovanni Cardinal Simeoni believed America needed to see its first black Catholic priest and ensured that Fr. Tolton would be assigned there. After serving as the pastor of St. Joseph's, a black parish, he was reassigned to the Archdiocese of Chicago and served the black Catholic community there before dying of heat stroke at 43 years old.

Fr. Augustus Tolton leaves a legacy of faith and perseverance despite the odds. **Who in your life might God be calling to something extraordinary but just needs the encouragement in the faith that you can provide?** Take that next step and Walk With One! Martha Tolton encouraged her son Augustus in the faith. Fr. Peter McGirr encouraged his pursuit of the priesthood. **Who will you walk with during this holiday season?**
