To: Those Who Are Called By My Name: The People Of The Body Of Christ

Subject: I WON'T GO BACK. For if I build again the things which I destroyed I make myself a transgressor.

Galatians 2:18

Greetings in the name of Jesus:

For the Lord has reveal it unto me that his people come up with and allow fleshy and worldly thoughts along with not really wanting to walk in the true word for their own reason. They use the grace of God as a way to escape back to the weak and beggarly elements (Galatians 4:8-9), but the word of God tells us to frustrate not the grace and not to take occasion because of the liberty that the Lord gives us to walk in the flesh (Galatians 2:21; Gal 5:13). They also use for we have all sin and fall short (Romans 3:23) but when are we ourselves going to make an attempt to stop falling. Some things that we go through in the flesh the Lord allow, in other word his will, but be it so there is a time and a season for even that. I don't believe that Jesus would have told us to be perfect (Matt 5:48) if it was something that was impossible.

◆ First of all the Lord I serve is not traditional (Gal 3:3; 2 Peter 2:20-22) therefore I WON'T GO BACK.

◆ To come out of fornication (Col 3:5) but now it's alright to have a boyfriend or a girlfriend and live with them according to man that's ok. Yet to be a homosexual or lesbian these are deadly sins. I WON'T GO BACK.

◆ For a woman to dress herself properly (1 Tim 2:9) yet to go back to pants, to raising her dress back up, or to go from a little makeup or no makeup at all to a lot of makeup (Jeremiah 4:30). I WON'T GO BACK.

♦ Men being God's Glory (1 Cor 11:7) but boasting in themselves (Prov 27:2). Being humble at one time now you can't tell them anything because they are haughty. Taking God's glory (1 Thess 5:18; Isaiah 42:8) but don't want to be responsible for their family knowing what the word says (1 Tim 5:8; 1 Tim 3:5) and also not dwelling with their wife according to knowledge (1 Peter 3:7) but instead they treat them like a piece of meat. I WON'T GO BACK. ◆ To not walk in the truth makes it impossible to have an honorable marriage (Hebrews 13:4). I WON'T GO BACK.

◆ To not walk in the truth makes it hard to flee youth lust (2 Tim 2:22). I WON'T GO BACK.

◆ To not want the whole truth also makes it unbelievable for someone to say that they love their neighbors as themselves (Matt 22:39). In my flesh there is no good thing (Romans 7:18) but walk in the spirit and you will not fulfill the lust of the flesh. I WON'T GO BACK.

◆ Going to church and being religious, so call praising the Lord, (I refuse for mine's to be), is just vanity and vexation of the spirit (Ecc 4:16; Matt 7:23). I WON'T GO BACK.

Basically it's time out for playing hooky with the Lord. That being said, walking today in the whole truth but tomorrow walking in a whole different way is the same as traditions of man. Somebody suppose to be new when you are in Christ (2 Cor 5:17). Now as to Galatians 2nd chapter Paul begins to talk about how in a discreet way he preached the gospel but not that he came down on the word but instead just plainly led by the Lord. Even in the fourth verse when he says "and that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus that they might bring us into bondage", what he was saying people in the body of Christ who are not walking or whether don't want to walk in the word of God will try every thing that's including even trying to use God's word to get you to go back into things that the Lord has freed you from. Ex: To make you a fornicator again or and an adulterer/adulteress, to make you depend on alcohol again, and to bring you back to observing days, months and years (Easter, Santa Claus).
