


- Bible Studies: We have many Bible Studies from which to choose. Check the calendar for times and places or call the church office (760) 872-2261.

A New Season, a New Partner, Same Ministry

A new day dawned this summer, one where the storm of the night before left boulders in the washed out road, homes and a church building with mud inside, and me a little bewildered as to how we get from where we were to the community in which we were going to serve in. At the other end of the road was the Executive Director of Missions Door, Mike Fleischmann, letting me know by phone that he would be waiting when I arrived. It was the perfect word picture of how I came to partner as a missionary with Missions Door.

I celebrated my 15th year serving the Lord in the Eastern Sierra's and Nevada this summer with 27 Vacation Bible School programs and a Bible Camp that hosted over 121 kids-that first year we had 6 Vacation Bible Schools and no plan of building a camp. I stand amazed at how far God has led us to come.

When InFaith chose for me to no longer be one of their missionaries, I felt like the Israelites in Egypt, a little lost as to what or where God wanted me to go or do next. Then the churches I had partnered with here asked me if I would come and serve as their missionary. The wonderful leadership at First Presbyterian offered to take care of the collecting of your giving with the church partnership, and I stepped out in faith and continued to serve full-time. The Lord has continued to lead and quide me in the day to day choices for ministry; however, I must admit though that somewhere along the way I was standing at the Red Sea and asking God part the waters for me to join with another tribe of people serving Him. What am I trying to say with all of this allegory? I wanted to serve with a missions agency because I get to be part of a bigger team. I have been prayerfully waiting for God to part the waters so I may move forward with a new partner.

Some of you may be asking what does being a part of a missions agency do to help me with ministry in CA and Nevada. As some of you may have heard, sometimes I am a busy lady. Consistency in my ministry, being present in the lives of the families I work with, and bringing forth the gospel are all things that I love and thrive on. In the years of working with First Presbyterian I have had to take over the managing of my taxes, insurance, retirement, tax donation letters and other business things-all things that take me away from my first love. As I said above, First Presbyterian has been a wonderful partner to me the last several years; however, I am excited that Missions Door has a team in place to help with so many of the administrative parts of my job. I am not just partnering for the administration side. There is a greater ministry I will be joining called Harvest America, a team of other missionaries who are trying to bring the gospel to the lost.

I am excited for this next step in my ministry. This letter is my invitation to you to get to know Missions Door and the ministry they have. It is also my opportunity to thank you for your continued love and support of the kids and ministry here in the Eastern Sierra Nevada area


