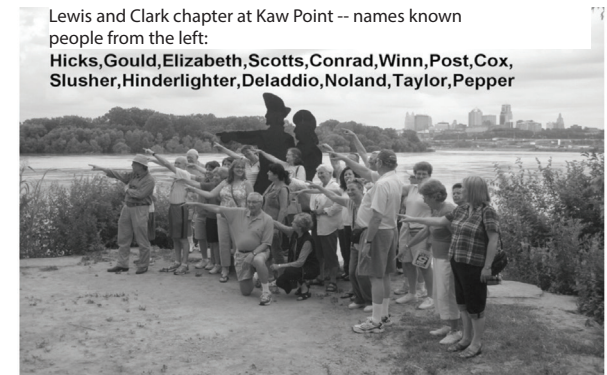

JOURNAL QUOTES

Clark wrote in his journal on June 27, 1804 as the corps of Discovery camped at the bend to the north on the Missouri River:

- “A fair warm morning, the river rose a little last night. We determine to delay at this place three or four days to make observations and recruit the party...”
- “The Countrey about the mouth of this (Kansas) river is very fine on each side as well as the North of the Missouries...”

Private Whitehouse wrote on June 27:

- “Cleared off the point and formed a temporary brest work -- least the savages would attempt coming in the night.”
