The Lewis and Clark Trail offers extraordinary opportunities for picturesque photographs.

Scenic mountains, thick forests, plains of unquestionable beauty, rivers great and small, abundant wildlife, dramatic statues of the explorers, experiences of Lewis and Clark enthusiasts—these are only a few of the countless memories that can be captured by a camera lens.

With that thought in mind, the Lewis and Clark Trail Heritage Foundation is inviting amateur photographers—those with camera or a cell phone camera—to enter a photo contest. Photographs will be chosen to be used in the LCTHF 2022 calendar and for other purposes of the organization.

Photographs must be taken within the Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail corridor or at other Lewis and Clark historic sites.

LCTHF members can submit one to two photographs in up to each of three categories. Non-members may submit one photo each in up to two categories (or [become a LCTHF member](#) and have the same submission opportunities as members)

Here are the categories to choose from:

- Landscape.
- People on the trail.
- Historic Lewis and Clark sites;
- Public Lewis and Clark art.
- Flora and fauna.

Photos must be submitted in a high-definition format. The deadline to enter is April 30. Entries will be reviewed by four judges. Winners will be announced June 15.
