
From the Pastor ...

This month we celebrate Easter, also known as Resurrection Day. The resurrection of Jesus is the foundation of our faith.

If Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith. And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost. If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are to be pitied more than all men. (1 Corinthians 15:14, 17-19)
