### *Welcome to our guest speaker, Jack Eason!*

Jack Eason is an author and speaker, traveling to churches, colleges and high schools talking about the issue of loneliness (popular after the worldwide pandemic), how we can make good friends, and the power of togetherness.

Jack also serves ministries and non-profits throughout the United States and around the world sharing principles for fundraising, growth and development, board governance, and other areas of ministry leadership through the Heart Share Group, sharing practical lessons he learned while running his own non-profit ministry, CUPS Mission, where he serves as Executive Director.

CUPS Mission is a ministry that has been privileged to serve the local church in the Dominican Republic, Malawi in Africa, and Mexico City. The ministry's goal is first and foremost to share the good news of Jesus Christ with local children and their families. In addition, CUPS Mission provides year round discipleship programs for the kids and vocational programs for young adults, teaching life skills that will have a lasting impact on their families and future children.


