I am thankful for our Revitalization team. Their purpose is to use the data we received from last year's Assessment Report and other resources to develop ways to move us forward. This summer, ministry teams will meet to plan for the fall and beyond. We might be restarting Women's and Men's ministries. We would like to amp up our Seniors' ministry to find a way to reach the high number of seniors in our community who are not connected with any church. In addition, one of the mostly unreached people groups that the assessment revealed are singles in and around Hartsville. This group includes those who never married and those who are single again. I was surprised to read in the Assessment that about 42% a families within a ten-minute drive to our Church are single parent families. Imagine if our Church had a ministry that specialized in that specific need. Right now we do not have a leader for this.
