Remember, the last Sunday in October is the Sunday we celebrate our 175th anniversary as First Baptist Church. Plan on being here and bringing as many people as you can—especially those who don't attend church on a regular basis.

After that Sunday, what's next? I thank the Lord for our Revitalization Strategy Team. They are working on developing ministries that meet the felt needs and real needs of our community. Below are some ideas.

As you read through this list, pray about which ministry God might be pulling you toward. The goal is to meet a few times during the summer months, so that it is a solid option for churched and nonchurched people to connect with us in November.

As you will see, some of these ministries are already up and running. At the Revitalization Core Group workshop last month, people at different tables described what these ministries could look like at their best, and what would it take to make that happen. Pretty much every ministry will require volunteers. Pray now if you would like to join a team to help start a new ministry or improve an existing one.

- > Singles ministry. The Revitalization Assessment report from last year revealed that 42% of family units within a ten-minute drive of our church are single parent families. Add the singles and singleagain without kids demographics to that and you can see a gold mine of opportunity for our church to reach an often overlooked need.
- Seniors ministry. More retired people are moving to South Carolina than ever before—some in our area. Their biggest need: connecting, belonging, and befriending people their age. We could be the church where that happens!

Safety team ministry. This last weekend our team was on alert for a credible threat for all churches in Hartsville. Nothing happened. The police arrested the person of interest in Lee County that morning. I am so thankful for our safety response team. At the same time, it reminded us that we could use more team members who are trained. Just a reminder—it is still illegal for anyone to carry a firearm on a church campus unless they are qualified, trained, and approved members of a safety team and their names are listed in the Church office.

If you have a passion and skill for the ministries above, or a ministry not mentioned above, please let me know! Our church needs to be "all in" for us to turn the corner toward fulfilling the Great Commission and experiencing healthy church growth.

Part of our vision to achieve this is hiring a Next Generation Associate Minister (NGAM). Our NGAM search team has reviewed multiple resumes and interviewed several candidates. They recommended one that they and I believe will serve an important roll in our revitalization. We have been planning and praying for the right person for this position for more than a year, and presented Eric Groves last Sunday in church.
