## What I have committed to do as a disciple:

1. To put God first in my finances.

## A 10 percent tithe of all income works to get where I want to be financially.

(Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house, and test me now in this, . . . if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there will not be room enough for. - Malachi 3:10)

2. To remember why Jesus came.

Jesus came, by the will of God, his Father, to teach us how to live abundant, fulfilled lives. (Don't be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the Kingdom. - Luke 12:32) – Not just the Kingdom of Heaven, but also the joy of a life richly led here on earth. (I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly. – John 10:10)

- 3. To keep his commandments and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

  (If you love me, keep my commandments.
