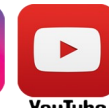

Sermon Notes

"A CHURCH THAT IS VIBRANT" 2 Corinthians 3:17-4:1-18

A relationship with Jesus Christ is to affect the way we walk and talk, live and relate.

A church that is VIBRANT...

1. REFLECTS THE LIGHT OF CHRIST (v. 6)

In order for us to reflect His glory we must be:

- Overcome by Him
- Occupied by Him
- Obedient to Him

"We do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus as Lord." (v. 5)

The lost have a desperate need to see the real Jesus.

"A saint is a person the light shines through."

2. RADIATES THE LIFE OF CHRIST (v. 7)

We don't radiate our revived life, but His resurrected life.

A vibrant church is one that has resounding Life, and that life comes from the source, Jesus Christ, our Risen Savior.

3. REVERES THE LORDSHIP OF CHRIST

For a church to be vibrant...it must be filled with people who have repented of their sins, who have been baptized, and who have been filled with the Holy Spirit. You can't fake it. It is Holy Spirit produced.

Problem...We have an enemy who will do whatever he can to keep us from this kind of life; he will put whatever obstacles, excuses, discouragement, and distractions he can to keep us from finding Jesus.
