Sermon Outline

“FULFILLING YOUR CALL”

Ephesians 3:1-13

God’s plan was and is to save us; not by works, but by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone at the cross. Jesus did all the work.

In Chapter 3, Paul begins:

“For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles...” (Ephesians 3:1)

Paul understood that he was a prisoner of the Lord. As the prisoner of the Lord he was...

1. THE MESSENGER OF CHRIST

“Although I am less than the least of all the Lord’s people, this grace was given me; to preach to the Gentiles the boundless riches of Christ.” (Ephesians 3:8)

Paul was the messenger of Christ entrusted with...

2. THE MYSTERY OF CHRIST

“The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our sons forever, that we may observe all the words of this law.” (Deuteronomy 29:29)

There are also some things that God chooses to reveal. A NT mystery is a truth hidden in the heart of God that you and I could only know if He chooses to reveal it to us.

2. THE MYSTERY OF CHRIST - continued

The New Testament speaks of several mysteries...

- The mystery of Christ and His cross. (1 Corinthians 2:7-8)
- The mystery of Christ and His Coming again. (1 Corinthians 15:51-52)
- The mystery of Christ and His church. (Ephesians 5:32)

3. THE MINISTRY OF CHRIST (vv. 7-8)

Paul is saying that he had a mystery that was too good to keep.

“To me, the very least of all saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ.”
