- 1. Application required
- 2. Background check will be completed

- 3. Must go through a 16 hour basic training
- Certificate of completion will be received upon completion of training
- 5. Uniform requirements
  - a. 3 shirts
  - b. 1 fleece
  - c. 1 safety vest
  - d. 1 wind breaker
  - e. Black uniform pants
  - f. Black working shoes
  - g. Photo Id badge with number
  - h. Neat and clean appearance at all times
  - Only wear uniforms when engaging in Chaplain duties during calls and emergencies
  - j. Written notice required to be removed from the Chaplain program
- 6. Chaplains must be actively involved in the Inter Faith Chaplain program and uphold the integrity of the Chaplains. The President of The Interfaith Chaplain program has the right to dismiss any Chaplain if he/she feels they are not representing or upholding the standards of the Interfaith Chaplains.
- 7. Training Fee
  - a. Yearly dues \$75 due annually
    - i. Must be renewed yearly
    - ii. If non-renewal all items must be returned to Interfaith Chaplain president
- 8. Meetings
  - a. Three required per year
