**#1** Scripture: Genesis 6:5 to 7.....

## *The Wickedness of Man*

*...5 Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.*

*6The LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart.*

*The True Meaning of this class*
