

#### **1969 TRIVIA**

The "Sting Ray name" was not used on the 1968 Corvette, but returned in 1969, this time spelled "Stingray" as one word.

Corvette had its first all aluminum engine in 1969 as the ZL-1. It was not the first GM automobile to do so, however, being beaten by the Corvair in 1960 and the Buick 215 V8.

Only two 1969 Corvettes were sold with the ZL-1 all aluminum 427 engine, making them one of the rarest collector Corvettes of all time. Note: Visit Roger's Corvette Center in Orlando, Florida, for a close-up look at an original 1969 ZL-1.

In 1969, the ignition lock was moved from the dash to the steering column. It would remain there until 1997 when it was returned to the dash.
















#### **Corvette Museum to Manage Tours of the Corvette Assembly Plant**

Like so many others, I've been to the National Corvette Museum numerous times over the past 20-plus years.

The highlight for me and my family has always been the tours of the Corvette Assembly Plant across the street. Seeing our favorite car come to life never gets boring.

In the past, only three tours were scheduled each day, making it hard to get tickets during busy times of the year.

Now, though, the National Corvette Museum will be in charge of managing the public tours of the factory, and what that means for enthusiasts is a much expanded schedule.

In fact, according to a release from the Museum, starting in the next few weeks, tours will be available every 15 minutes, with the first tour at 8:30 a.m. CT and the last tour leaving at 1:45 p.m. CT.

Tickets have gone up slightly, to \$10 for adults and \$5 for youth ages 10-16, but now a discounted combo ticket for the Plant and Museum is available for just \$16. For what you will be treated to, that ranks as one of the biggest entertainment bargains around!

"We are in the business to build cars," said GM Bowling Green Assembly Plant Manager Kai Spande. "The National Corvette Museum is in the hospitality and tourism business and currently leads a number of tour programs in the plant, including R8C Museum Delivery, Experience, VIP Tours, Photo Albums and Buyers' Tours. It was only fitting to add the public tour program to their list of offerings."

If you want to make sure you get into the factory tour, you can buy tickets for the plant tours online at www.corvetteplanttours.com or you can gamble and buy your tickets at the Museum or Plant. The combo tickets will be available online or at either location. Online tickets have to be purchased at least 24 hours before your tour time.

As before, the plant tours, which last about an hour, are usually available Monday through Friday (unless something is going on at the factory – you can check those dates at www.corvetteplanttours.com).

By the way, no cell phones, cameras, crutches, purses, backpacks, or electronic devices are allowed on the tour, and closed toe and closed heel shoes are required. Wheelchairs on a first come, first serve basis are available for free.



## Corvette Hall of Fame



#### Legendary Corvette Designer Larry Shinoda

Larry Shinoda was born March 25, 1930 in Los Angeles, California. Like typical So-Cal boys, he loved cars and would draw pictures of them. As a teen, he enjoyed hotrodding and street racing and his pursuits of all things automotive eventually led him to Art Center College of Design.

College wasn't for him though and labeled as a malcontent, he was kicked out of art school. One of his teachers invited him to present some of his designs to Ford and he was hired a few months later. Larry spent a year at Ford, and then worked for nine months at Packard before landing a design job at General Motors.

Petrolicios tells the story of one night when Shinoda was driving home from work, none other than GM's Bill Mitchell pulled up next to Larry's T-Bird at a stop light. When the light turned green, Mitchell took off in his supercharged Pontiac, but Shinoda's Thunderbird was modded with a Stroppe race-prepped Ford stock car engine and he easily outran GM's Design Chief.

A few days later, Mitchell tracked down the White Thunderbird at the Chevy Design Studio and asked Shinoda to pull it into the garage. When Mitchell saw the car was equipped with a full roll cage, two four-barrel carburetors, headers and heavy duty shocks, he "just about had a heart attack." The story goes that Mitchell recognized Shinoda as a die-hard racer and he was immediately switched to the Corvette program.

As part of the Corvette program, Shinoda worked on refining several concepts, including one that would become the 1963 Corvette Sting Ray Split-Window Coupe. Larry also penned both Mako Shark concepts, the rear-engined XP-819 concept and the engineering test vehicles known as CERV I and CERV II.

Shinoda left GM in 1968, hired away by Former GM executive Bunkie Knudsen. His first design at Ford was a high performance version of the Mustang which he called "Boss", a tribute to Knudsen.

Following his short stint at Ford, Shinoda opened his own design studio where he consulted with various automakers. As a freelancer, he helped design the Jeep ZJ for American Motors Corp. The Jeep would eventually become the Grand Cherokee.

Larry would return to Corvette designing in the early 1990s with Indy 500 winner Rick Mears to produce the Shinoda Mears Corvette, a C4 Corvette improved with a custom body kit that actually improved the drag coefficient of the regular C4 Crovette from .34 to .30.

Larry passed away in the late 1997 at the age of 67 but his contributions to two American icons, Corvette and Mustang, will forever live on.

## Milestone Reached in Construction of the Corvette Assembly Plant's New Paint Shop

All you Corvette enthusiasts excited about the new paint shop at the Corvette Assembly Plant in Bowling Green can rest a little easier today.

General Motors announced that the final piece of steel in the \$439 million paint shop was installed Wednesday, and construction remains on track for the first Corvette to be painted in the new facility on April 1, 2017.



"That's our major goal," said Marc Roberts, site project manager, "and we are on schedule."

GM broke ground for the new state-of-the-art facility in September, and the first piece of steel was installed in December.

"It's amazing how much construction has gone on in four months," said Nora Roper, assistant plant manager. "We're thrilled with the continued success of the Bowling Green Assembly Plant."

The final piece of steel, an I-beam that had been signed by many construction workers and staff, was lifted to the top of the three-story building and bolted into place.

That I-beam was one of the 6,800 pieces of steel in the structure "safely and on schedule," according to Roberts. The structure also includes 3,000 feet of walls and 200,000 square feet of concrete floor in the massive 870,000-square-foot building being constructed next to the existing facility where Corvettes have been assembled since 1981.

Of course, the most important part of the new facility has yet to be installed – the actual painting equipment that is expected to greatly improve the quality of the paint jobs on some 2017 Corvettes.

Plant Manager Kai Spande explained the need for the new facility by noting: 'What's different for the Corvette is we're painting plastic and composite materials and doing panel painting (separately), and they all need to match."



## Will GM Offer the Camaro ZL1's 10-Speed Automatic Transmission for the Corvette Z06?

Earlier this month, Chevrolet introduced the new 2017 Camaro ZL1 that will be coming later this year. The new 6th generation ZL1 is powered by the Corvette Z06's LT4 V8. In a move that will please Corvette Z06 owners, Chevy has backed the ZL1's LT4 power rating down slightly to 640 hp and 640 lb-ft of torque in a move that keeps the Z06 as Chevrolet's "Big Nasty" when it comes to horsepower.



The track ready ZL1 will be equipped with a 6-speed manual transmission which is interesting as Chevrolet has the 7-speed manual available in the parts bin. But the real news is that a new 10-speed automatic transmission will be offered with the car.

The 10-speed paddle-shift automatic transmission was developed jointly with Ford, although Chevrolet says in the ZL1 press release that the quick shift automatic features hardware and unique calibrations exclusive for the new Camaro.

According to Chevrolet, the Camaro ZL1's 10-speed automatic has a 7.39 overall ratio for smaller steps between gears. It enables the LT4 engine to remain at optimal rpm levels during acceleration, particularly when exiting corners, for quicker laps and lightning-quick responses on both up- and downshifts.

The press release also confirms that by the end of 2018, GM will introduce the new 10-speed automatic in eight vehicle models.

So what does this mean for the Corvette **Z06**?

It seems a given that Chevrolet will make available the new 10-speed auto for Corvettes and particularly the Z06 if the ZL1 is offering essentially the same powertrain. The benefits of the 10-speed auto are two-fold. First, the extra cogs were designed to handle more torque than a CVT can in their present state and they will help increase the fuel economy standards for the powerful, rear-wheel drive cars, trucks and SUVs they were developed for.

With the pressure that automakers are under to raise fuel economy standards where ever possible, it wouldn't make sense for GM to not offer the new transmission for the Z06 or even the Stingray for that matter.

The press release and subsequent interviews with key GM executives say the Camaro ZL1 will be the first General Motors car to receive the transmission. As the ZL1 is expected "in late 2017", we figure that means if it does comes to the Corvette Z06, it will most likely happen in 2018 as the 2017 Corvette Z06 production will already be underway before the first Camaro ZL1s come off the assembly line.

GM spokesman Tom Read told *Automotive News* that GM will continue to offer its current eight-speed automatic, which is available in Cadillacs and Corvettes.

The 2018 model year has been on our radar for quite some time as it marks the 5th year of the C7 Corvette. 2018 will be first full production year with the Corvette Assembly Plant's new \$439 million paint shop which we believe will create the necessary space for a secondary production line for the much rumored Corvette ZORA ZR1 mid-engine model.

Should C7 Corvette production continue into 2018 and beyond, then it could possible we are seeing the first signs that Chevrolet will offer a mid-production powertrain upgrade for all three Corvette models to help stimulate sales and keep the C7 line-up fresh.

So yes, we believe the Corvette Z06 will receive the new 10-speed automatic transmission. The real question is when...

#### Doug Fehan: "Corvette Racing is the World's Best GT Racing Team"

After Corvettes have won the last five of the world's top endurance races, Corvette Racing Program Manager Doug Fehan has seen enough.

With the team's latest performance, last Saturday's Sebring 12 Hour win, Fehan declared that Corvette Racing is the best in its class.



It's hard to argue.

Corvette Racing has now won Daytona and Sebring in 20015 and 2016, along with the 24 Hours of Le Mans in 2015.

The win at Sebring last week was particularly sweet because the #3 Corvette of Jan Magnussen, Antonio Garcia, and Mike Rockenfeller was knocked out after a scuffle with the #911 Porsche. That left it up to the #4 car of Oliver Gavin, Tommy Milner, and Marcel Fassler to pick up the torch and run with it.

And run they did.

Despite being two laps down with six hours to go, the #4 Corvette roared back with Milner behind the wheel at the end to win by 2.882 seconds.

"It takes an effort like this to win in this race and in this series," Fehan said. "We're racing against the world's best. And today we demonstrated why Corvette Racing is the world's best GT racing team."

Fehan thought he had seen it all with the big wins at Le Mans and Daytona, but then "Corvette Racing comes back from one of our cars being taken out and the other going two laps down with six hours to go, and standing here in Victory Lane..."

The superlatives poured out of Fehan, who added: "It's a great team, great drivers, tremendous strategy and engineering, flawless execution on pit stops."

Likewise, Chevrolet U.S. Vice President Jim Campbell was impressed.

"Great driving, teamwork and execution in the pits were keys to the GTLM class victory," he said. "To come from two laps down and win in a field as competitive as the IMSA GTLM class is a true reflection of the never-give-up attitude of the Corvette Racing team."

Milner sensed a win when he climbed in for the final laps. "...when I got in at the end, I've never had a race car that good," he said. "That Corvette was absolutely on rails and I could tell as soon as I left pit lane... I immediately knew we had a fast racecar."

Gavin summed up the past year with these comments: "This is 60 hours of racing that we've won in the last 12 months with the No. 4 – Le Mans, Daytona and now Sebring. That is just amazing."

#### **March 2016 Corvette Sales**

GM released their corporate sales report for March 2016 on Friday morning. Corvette sales for March totaled 2,753 cars, a decrease of -27.3% over the same time in 2015 which saw Corvette sales at 3,785 units. For the Calendar Month to Date, GM has sold 6,370 Corvettes, a decrease over 2015's total of 8,517 or -25.2%.



Corvette sales continue to rise following the dip in C7 sales in January where only 1,501 Corvettes were sold. In February 2016, those sales grew to 2,116 and now March's total is 2,753. That's a month to month increase of 637 cars or 30.1% from February to March.

GM delivered 193,524 vehicles in March to retail customers which was up 6% year over year. Much of the growth is fueled by Chevrolet whose retail sales were up 10% in the first quarter over a year ago and a retail market share that has grown to an estimated 11%. The new Malibu sales are 65% higher as well as the new Camaro which saw sales up 23%. Chevy truck sales are up 6% with the Colorado up 44%.

#### 4,000 HP Corvette with a Hemi Twin Turbo

This is not your father's Chevrolet, for sure.

The behemoth hiding under the massive hood is a 548 Hemi crate motor that's been fitted with a couple of Precision 102mm turbos to produce insane amounts of power. In fact, when the hood is lifted off this Corvette, it really does begin to look like a monster has managed to escape from the Corvette Assembly Plant.



Only Tadge Juechter and crew didn't create this monster.

For all the unrealness that oozes from this Stingray, which is fitted with a three-speed transmission, a billet solid rear axle, massive exhaust tips coming out just in front of the doors, and interestingly enough narrow tires, it's ironic – and more than a little funny – that the owners saw fit to leave the VIN plate intact on the dash, not to mention the removable panel still on the roof. That's right, you can take the roof panel off and let the wind blow through your hair at 200+ mph if that's what your heart desires! We'd be too scared silly to worry about the wind-blown look, though. You'll also note that everything from the windshield back is pretty much factory, too.

You have to admire these guys for having the gumption (and the money) to take a 76-mile 2014 Corvette and let some "mad scientists" go wild with it and turn it into a "Sting-N-Stein."

#### Man Gets 146 Days in Jail for Crashing His Corvette into Girlfriend's Home

Fleeing from police and crashing his C4 Corvette into two patrol cars and then into the side of the house he shared with his then-girlfriend led to jail time and fines for a Maine man this week.

Edwin Munson, 68, of Winthrop, Maine made the headlines last June 3 in the midst of an apparent domestic dispute.



He first went to the home of the woman's son, threatened to burn his house down and shoot him, but then took off in his gray Corvette when told that police were on the way.

Troopers quickly spotted the Corvette, but Munson fled, eventually crashing into two patrol cars during the pursuit through several towns before finally making his way to Annabessacook Road, where he lived in a house with his then-girlfriend. He crashed into the house, where no one was home.

Munson pleaded guilty to two counts each of eluding an officer and aggravated criminal mischief, and one count each of driving to endanger and terrorizing.

Monday, Munson was sentenced to serve 146 days in jail, with the rest of a four-year sentence suspended. He'll be on probation for two years, followed by a one-year period of administrative release imposed for a terrorizing offense. If he violates that release, he could be ordered to serve another 364-day sentence that was suspended.

In addition, his driver's license was suspended for 30 days, and he'll have to pay \$3,087 in restitution and a \$1,150 fine.

#### First VIN 001 2017 Corvette Grand Sport Collector's Edition Sells for \$170,000

Two surprises were in store for us on the first day of the 2016 Barrett-Jackson Auction in Palm Beach. On Friday at 6:00 pm, the first retail 2017 Corvette Grand Sport Collector's Edition was auctioned for charity. While the general consensus was that this vehicle would be just another in a long line of VIN 001 Corvettes purchased at auction by Rick Hendrick, it in fact was sold to another



dealership owner at what is generally regarded as a bargain price for a VIN 001 Corvette.

First, a little about the 2017 Corvette Grand Sport. We saw the Grand Sport Collector's Edition Coupe for the first time today and we wondered what our reaction would be to seeing the Torsion Blue interior against the new Watkins Glen Gray exterior. Well, we love it! Such a bold combination in our opinion and the comments we heard from the general public as they viewed the car was about the same.

Once the car was outside, the Watkins Glen Gray really looks sharp. The Grand Sport really held no surprises for us after it was revealed a month ago in Geneva, however we did find something new when the hood was opened. The hood liner features the C7 logo and "Grand Sport". The dash plaque inside was hard to get a photo of, but we do see that it reads "0/1,000" which again suggests that there will 1,000 Collector's Edition produced. The real question is how many will stay in the USA vs those that are exported.

Chevrolet celebrated the Grand Sport by giving away free t-shirts at the Chevrolet display which had the "Grand Sport" name on it and the line was pretty long all afternoon leading up to the sale. Once the car was on stage, members of the Karmanos Cancer Institute, the organization that benefited from the charity sale, handed out matching "Grand Sport" hats as well.

Bidding on the car was fairly steady with one break in the bidding to ramp up additional support. The Corvette reached a high bid of \$170,000 when the hammer dropped. Winning the car the automotive dealer David Flynn, who bought the first retail Cadillac ATS in last year's Palm Beach auction which also benefited the Karmanos Cancer Institute.

#### Corvette Stingray Damaged in Four Vehicle Crash in California

A four-vehicle crash involving a red C7 Corvette Stingray at a busy intersection in Carlsbad, Calif., on Friday afternoon left several people injured, including one with possible lifethreatening injuries.

Police say the crash apparently happened when a 1999 Honda Civic with a 37-year-old behind the wheel slammed into three other vehicles, including two trucks and the Corvette.



Police say the Honda was headed westbound on Cannon Road. A Dodge Ram and the Corvette were going north on El Camino Real when they were hit by the Honda as it entered the intersection. The impact then sent the Honda crashing into a Chevrolet Silverado pickup that was stopped in the southbound El Camino Real turn lane waiting to go east on Cannon.

The impact was so strong that it ripped off the rear tire on the passenger side of the Corvette, with the tire ending up underneath the Silverado. In fact, the entire right side of the Stingray suffered extensive damage, and the rear hatch is missing, apparently cut off by emergency workers in the aftermath of the crash.

#### **The Top 100 Corvette Dealers of 2015**

33,329 Corvettes. That was about 1,500 cars less than in 2014 but considering that the Z06 makes up nearly one third of that production, you can bet the GM bean counters were happy with that number as well as the dealers who saw the Z06 fly off their lots in record time.

So who are the dealers that are selling the most Corvettes? Thanks to some official internal numbers, we are able to share the Top 100 Corvette Dealers for 2015.

First, we always to like offer a setup that by publishing this list, our goal is to educate potential buyers on knowing which Chevrolet dealers in your region or state that specialize in selling Corvettes.

There is nothing wrong with engaging your local small town dealership about the prospect of ordering or purchasing a Corvette and chances are even if you buy elsewhere, it's likely your scheduled maintenance will be handled locally. However, the benefits of working with a dealership that specializes in selling Corvettes are many. The salespeople tend to be more knowledgeable about the Corvette product offerings, their volume almost guarantees that allocation is available throughout the year, and many will offer discounts off of MSRP for a chance to handle your business.

Kerbeck Corvette in Atlantic City continue to dominate the list as the world's largest Corvette dealer with 1,268 Corvettes sold in 2015, an increase over the 1,245 Corvettes sold in 2014. The next three dealers all return in the same order as they were in 2014 although each total was slightly less in 2015 than 2014. Criswell

Chevrolet was 4th again with Corvette salesperson of the year (East Coast) Mike Furman singlehandedly selling 400 of the 427 Corvettes listed.

The rest of the Top 10 saw changes this year with Classic Chevrolet (Grapevine, TX) and Stingray Chevrolet (Plant City, FL) moving up the list while Van Chevrolet (Scottsdale, AZ) breaks into the Top 10.

#### Edmunds 2016 Best Retained Value Awards Names Corvette as Best Midrange Sports Car

Edmunds recently posted their award winners in a survey of best retained values for 2016. These are the brands and models that have the highest projected private party residual value five years after their launch.

The Chevrolet Corvette was named as the winner in the "Best Midrange Sports Car" segment with honorable mentions going out to the Porsche Cayman and Porsche Boxster.



Edmunds says knowing your vehicle's resale value is critical for car buyers as the smart shopper will choose a vehicle with high retained value so they can maximize their worth at trade-in or sale. Knowing the resale value is also key when leasing as the resale value is a key factor in determining the monthly lease payment.

This is the second consectuive year for Corvette to win its segment category in the Edmunds Best Retained Value Awards and the third time in four years.

The Chevrolet Corvette's retained value after five years was projected by Edmunds to be 53.9% while the category average is 49.2%:

We do note that the categories have changed slightly over the years during the survey. In 2016, there are two Sports Car Categories, the Midrange Sports Car which the Corvette topped and a Premium Sports Car Category which is headed by the Porsche 911.

The Corvette was the only model from Chevrolet to rank first in the survey with the Chevrolet Tahoe and Colorado earning Honorable Mentions in their respective segments. Other GM segment winners included the GMC Acadia in the Large Crossover SUV and the GMC Yukon which earned the nod in the Large Traditional SUV segment.

#### 2017 Camaro SS 50th Anniversary Edition to Pace the 100th Indianapolis 500

With Camaro celebrating its 50th
Anniversary in 2017, Chevy announced
that a special 2017 Camaro SS 50th
Anniversary Edition will be the official
pace car of the 100th running of the
Indianapolis 500. Driving the special pace
car will be motor sports legend Roger
Penske who is also celebrating his 50th
anniversary as a race team owner.



This will be the ninth time Camaro has paced the Indianapolis 500 and the first since 2014 when the 2014 Camaro Z/28 coupe led the pack.

Chevrolet will prepare four identical pace cars to support the race. The Camaro pace cars feature an exclusive Abalone White exterior with the "100th Running of the Indianapolis 500" graphics on the doors and the Indianapolis Motor Speedway logo on the quarter panels. The Camaro SS is powered by the LT1 V8 and makes 455 horsepower.

"Chevrolet and Roger Penske are inextricably linked to the heritage of the Indianapolis 500," said J. Douglas Boles, president of Indianapolis Motor Speedway. "When he leads the pack on May 29, behind the wheel of the Camaro SS, he will drive the race into its next 100 years and strengthen the bond Chevrolet and Indianapolis forged a century ago."

Roger Penske first tackled the Indianapolis 500 as a team owner in 1969 with driver Mike Donohue. Later, his stable of drivers would include some of the great names in racing including Mario Andretti, Al Unser and Rick Mears. Penske will be going for his 17th Indy 500 win as a team owner in 2016.

#### **Dude, Where's My 2016 Corvette's Performance Timer?**

If you have owned your 2016 Corvette for some time, no doubt that you have gotten into the C7's instrument panel and the Driver Information Center (DIC) to play with some of the settings. One of the "fun" items in the Performance Menu is the Performance Timer which will record your



speed from defined start and stop locations.

We've previously noted some threads on the Corvette Forum from mid-2015 which coincided with customers receiving their new 2016 Corvettes and some have reported the Performance Timer missing from their 2016's DIC menu.

Chevy has finally said that it was a programming error and that 2016 Corvettes do indeed come with the Performance Timer. To follow up, Chevrolet has issued a service bulletin (#15814) dated March 2016 to address these Corvettes missing the feature.

The service bulletin notes that the number of 2016 Corvettes involved is approximately 10,933 vehicles:

#### **PURPOSE**

This bulletin provides a service procedure to reprogram the Instrument Panel Cluster (IPC) with an updated calibration on certain 2016 model year Chevrolet Corvette vehicles. These vehicles may be missing the Performance Timer in the instrument cluster.

This service procedure should be completed as soon as possible on involved vehicles currently in dealer inventory and customer vehicles that return to the dealer for any type of service during the New Vehicle Limited Warranty coverage period.

#### VEHICLES INVOLVED

All involved vehicles are identified by VIN in the Global Warranty Management System – Investigate Vehicle History Application. Dealership technicians should always check this site to confirm vehicle involvement prior to beginning any required inspections and/or repairs. It is important to routinely use this tool to verify eligibility because not all similar vehicles may be involved regardless of description or option content. Additionally, a list of involved vehicles currently in dealer inventory can be found in GlobalConnect, under Departments, Service, Field Action Inventory Reports (US) or attached to the GlobalConnect message (Canada) used to release this bulletin. Customer vehicles that return for service, for any reason, and are still covered under the vehicle's base warranty should also be checked for vehicle eligibility.

To see if your 2016 Corvette is one of the 10,933 Corvettes effected, go the Driver Information Center, select the Performance Menu and see if it's listed there. If not, your dealer can reprogram your instrument panel to include the feature. For questions, call your Chevrolet dealer's service department.
