If you give up, take heart. You're in very good company. As author John Rataczak makes clear in his new book *The Ramifications of Our Salvation*, very few people, even those who accept Christ as their savior, can speak knowledgeably about their salvation.

By this, John means that very few people are familiar with the important words and concepts contained in the Bible that pertain to their salvation. This is usually the case, he notes, even when they can describe in vivid and emotional terms how they felt at the moment they were saved or who they were with when they were saved.

He asks, "Should we rely primarily on circumstances and emotions to explain to others and ourselves what took place when we were saved? Are these things reliable?"

He answers his own question, explaining that when we do this, we are in some ways attempting to interpret Biblical truth by emotions and/or circumstances instead of as expressed in the Word of God.

Accordingly, *The Ramifications of Our Salvation* contains 35 chapters, 4 quizzes, a final exam, and an answer key that offers Christians a Bible-based understanding of their salvation. Significant sections of the book include:

- The Privileges of Our Salvation
