VICTORIA FALLS WORLD CHALLENGE PIGEON RACE

Summary - 2024 intake for 2025 Season

US\$ 1,166,000 over 10 competitions, 701 prizes with certificates, 50 Trophies. Plus Bonus Races.

Intake 2024. Races up to approximately 540 km. Final on 25 July 2025.

Entry Fee US\$ 600 plus US\$ 80 per bird perch fee.

RULES

- 1. One or more teams of 1 activated pigeon and up to 4 reserve pigeons.
- 2. There will be a minimum of three 100 km training flights before an activation race of 120 km. After the activation race fanciers have 7 days to activate their reserve pigeons. After 7 days the remaining reserves will be available for anyone to activate with breeders and ring numbers shown to Hotspot 3 and then only country shown and coded ring number thereafter.
- LOST PIGEON CREDIT for paid activations without reserves Lost before basketing of Hotspot 1 100% credit Lost after basketing of Hotspot 1 Nil
- 4. Vaccinate against **Paramyxovirus** at 21 to 24 days old (14 days before mixing with other flocks of pigeons).
- 5. Pigeons should preferably be between 45 and 60 days old when sent to the shipper.
- 6. Intakes by agents from September to December 2024.
- 7. 2024 and 2025 rings will be accepted.
- 8. Some pigeons will be selected for sale after racing. 50% of the net proceeds after sale costs for normal entries and 25% for Donor birds, paid to activator of the pigeon.
- 9. Birds not selected for sale may be bought by the activator for US\$ 300 and either placed in our breeding station or shipping and quarantine costs apply. This right is not transferable.
- 10. No previously raced pigeons can enter the race series.

COMPETITIONS

1. Final Race

A tough race of approximately 540 km over semi-arid African conditions starting in the South-East area and racing North-West, passing Hwange National Park wildlife reserve, which is 14,600 square kilometres in extent, with the thundering spray from the iconic *Victoria Falls* calling the birds home.

2. 5 Hotspot Races

3. Super Ace (highest points accumulated)

- 1. Staged from 6 race points, Hotspot 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and the Final.
- 2. Only activated birds at Hotspot 3 remain in the competition.
- 3. Super Ace pigeons don't have to clock in every race except the final.

4. Grand Average (points accumulated for all online flights except pre-training)

All pigeons included in the Grand Average competition up to and including Hotspot 2. Only pigeons activated before basketing Hotspot 3 will remain in the Grand Average.

5. Elite Competition (total points of 3 selected birds in each race from HS3)

- 1. Each fancier with own login account enters one group only. Select maximum of 7 activated birds before Hotspot 3 from all the pigeons in the same fancier login account. No changes to birds permitted.
- 2. Entrants with 7 activated pigeons or less will be entered automatically.
- 3. Points from first 3 Elite pigeons on HS 3, 4, 5 and Final to be added together.
- **4.** At least 1 Elite pigeon per race must be timed in race time for entrant to remain in the competition.

6. Knock Out Competition

- 1. Pigeons activated before Hotspot 3 will be entered into the knock out competition.
- 2. The 1st 50% of knock out pigeons basketed and clocked on Hotspots 3, 4 & 5 will continue.
- 3. The first remaining knock out pigeon returning in the final race will be the winner.
