While we are there we visit the modern city of 28 million people that is Shanghai, we visit Suhouz, Venice of the East with it's beautiful canals, laneways and markets. We visit Changshu where we meet up with our friends at our sister school. We travel by overnight sleeper train to Beijing where we visit the Forbidden City, Tiananmen Square and the Great Wall of China.

There are many wonderful sights and sounds – but the highlight for me is meeting up with our Chinese sister school. The relationships we have developed are very special and there are many families in our school who remain close friends with Chinese families they have hosted when they visited us.

During the 10 day trip we stay in motels and eat out at local restaurants. It is a busy schedule – but China is a busy place. The history, the culture, the sights and the sounds are amazing.

Parents must accompany their child(ren). This trip is mainly for Grade 5 and 6 students – but families decide on whether their child(ren) are ready for the adventure.

We travel in the October school holidays. The cost of flights will be about \$1200 return and the cost of in country accommodation, meals, travel (coach and train) and sight seeing is about \$1000.
