What is Market Day? This has been the question on our School Facebook Page this week. I will give a summary...

The Market Day will be held 30^{th} November, from 1pm to 2:30pm in the school courtyard. Grade 3-6 students run our school Market Day. In their classes, the students have sorted themselves into Market Day groups of 3-4 students. The groups then decided between them what sort of stall they would like to run.

Stalls generally fall under one of the following categories:

Fairground type games; coin toss, etc.
Providing a service, Face painting, nail painting, hair colouring, etc.
Selling a product; Baked goods, craft, cards, etc.

Generally, the students use class time to prepare their posters and other advertising materials and think about how they will run their stall. If students are selling a product these products are usually produced at home and bought to school on the day.

This year we will put the money raised to the purchase of a newer school van.

Students are able to bring money next Friday to spend at the stalls. All students in our school attend the Market Day. It is great if you can provide your child with lots of coins to spend. In the past products and services cost between 50 c and \$2 each.
