#### **Drought assistance information**

We have had lots of queries lately in relation to the drought assistance packages that are now available. East Gippsland has been declared a drought affected area and this has led to the creation of these packages.

Paynesville Primary School families have the ability to access both packages. The first package is for uniforms and assistance with school textbooks, this was sent to families at the end of the 2018 school year. If you require another application form please see the office. The second package is connected to camps, sports and excursions. The information for this package is included below and application forms have been attached to this newsletter.

#### DROUGHT ASSISTANCE FOR CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSIONS.

As part of the Victorian Government's drought assistance package, all Paynesville Primary School students are eligible for a drought assistance payment through the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF).

This includes parents/carers that do not hold a means-tested concession card, but are experiencing financial hardship as a result of drought conditions. Families who receive the means-tested CSEF payment are also eligible. A 'one off' amount of \$375 per student will be paid to the school to be used towards educational expenses for the direct benefit of your child.

#### How to apply

Complete the attached CSEF drought package application form (blue form) and return it to the school office or see the office for further information.

#### CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors, excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are part of a healthy curriculum. CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child. The annual CSEF amount per student is: \$125 for primary school students

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from www.education.vic.gov.au/csef

If you applied for the CSEF at Paynesville PS in 2018, you do not need to complete an application form in 2019 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- New student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools in 2019 or you did not apply in 2018.
- Changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2019.

Please see the office if you have any questions regarding this application process.
