The Department of Education defines bullying as

'Bullying is an ongoing and deliberate misuse of power in relationships through repeated verbal, physical and/or social behaviour that intends to cause physical, social and/or psychological harm. It can involve an individual or a group misusing their power, or perceived power, over one or more persons who feel unable to stop it from happening.'

The poster on this page puts this definition in to a fairly relatable format that can be used to generate discussion with primary school aged children.

support safe and respectful learning environments where bullying is not tolerated. The link below provides further information regarding the Departmet of Education school policy guidelines.




#### Easter Hat Parade


