
## Parent / Teacher Interviews

The School Interviews website is the same website we would use for face to face interviews so it can be a little confusing, as it gives the classroom number of each teacher. After you have made your booking through the School Interviews website, your child's classroom teacher will send you a WebEx invite via email so you can connect online at the interview time.

Bookings will close on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> August.

At these interviews, parents will have the opportunity to ask any questions they may have about their child's learning. We please request that your child attend as well, as the students will be sharing samples of their learning with you.

## Parent Opinion Survey

WE WANT OUR PARENTS/CAREGIVERS/GUARDIANS TO TELL US WHAT THEY THINK!

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what parents/caregivers/guardians think of our school. The Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education and Training that is conducted amongst a sample of randomly selected parents/caregivers/guardians (previously known as the Parent Opinion Survey). It is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, student engagement and experiences of remote and flexible learning. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies.

Approximately 30 per cent of parents will be invited to participate in this year's survey. All responses to the survey are anonymous. This year, the Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey will be conducted from **Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> August to Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September**. If you have been selected you would have received an email yesterday.

The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **20 minutes** to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the fieldwork period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in a range of languages other than English.
