The Children's eSafety Commissioner and the Australian Government have announced that as of July 1<sup>st</sup> the Enhancing Online Safety for Children Act 2015 will come in to play.

This is a big step in acknowledging that cyberbullying is incredibly harmful and can happen to anyone at any time. "The Act allows children suffering from serious cyberbullying to contact the office of the Children's eSafety Commissioner to have content removed."
