The District Swimming Carnival will be held at the same venue on Wed Feb 17th during school.


Paynesville Classic Boat Rally – March 5th and 6th

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Private music tuition lessons will be held weekly at school on Tuesday mornings for the following instruments:

Violin, Mandolin, Guitar, Ukulele or Recorder.

Group performances later in the year.

It is recommended that students are at least in grade 2 as there is reading involved. Cost of individual lessons is \$30 for half hour. Group of 2. \$15 each. (beginners only and at teachers discretion.)

Billing will be per term and will be sent out by the school. Students please pay at reception.

Students will need to provide their own musical instrument. Plus plastic sheet insert book. Please check with Kay before purchasing an instrument, as it is important the instrument is the correct size for the student.
