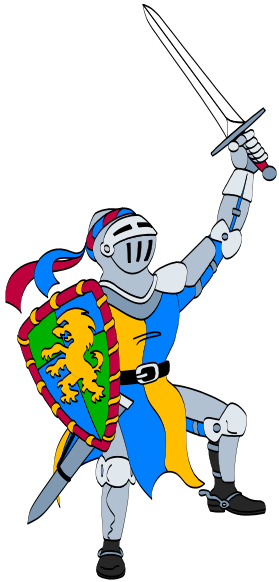


The Sword of the Spirit

Day 1

In Ephesians 6:11 we are told to put on the whole _____ of God so that we can be strong in the Lord. This week's memory

verse tells us about one part of this armor: the Sword of the Spirit. The verse says that the Word of God, the Bible, is **the Sword of the Spirit**.



When Jesus was tempted by satan (Matthew 4), He used the Bible to answer satan. Satan told Jesus three times to do something that was wrong, and each time Jesus responded with a verse from the Bible. The Bible is the most powerful weapon against satan. When someone you know tells you to do something that you know is wrong how can you use the Sword of the Spirit?

In Acts 2 Peter was preaching to some people in Jerusalem, and when he finished, verse 37 says that they were "pricked in their heart." This is called **conviction**. When they listened to God's Word, they understood that they had sinned. The truth from the Bible "pricked" their hearts like a sword, and they knew that they needed their sins forgiven. How could the Sword of the Spirit prick your heart? _____
