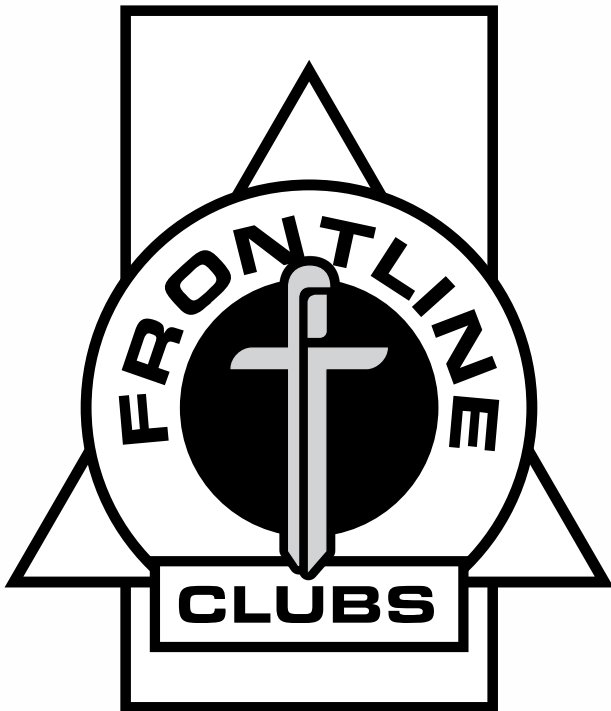

# AWARDS

A **Field Duty** is an activity that serves **those outside your household**. It must be either service-oriented or evangelistic in nature. Some examples of acceptable Field Duties include:

- Passing out no fewer than 10 tracts
- Bringing a visitor to a church service or club meeting
- Helping to fix a meal for a family in need
- Visiting someone in a nursing home or hospital
- Singing or playing an instrument in a church service
- Participating in a church work day
- Participating in a fundraising event for a ministry
- Helping an elderly neighbor or friend with yard work or household tasks

To receive credit for completing a Field Duty, fill out the form on the last page of the Journal week in which it was completed and have one of your parents sign it.

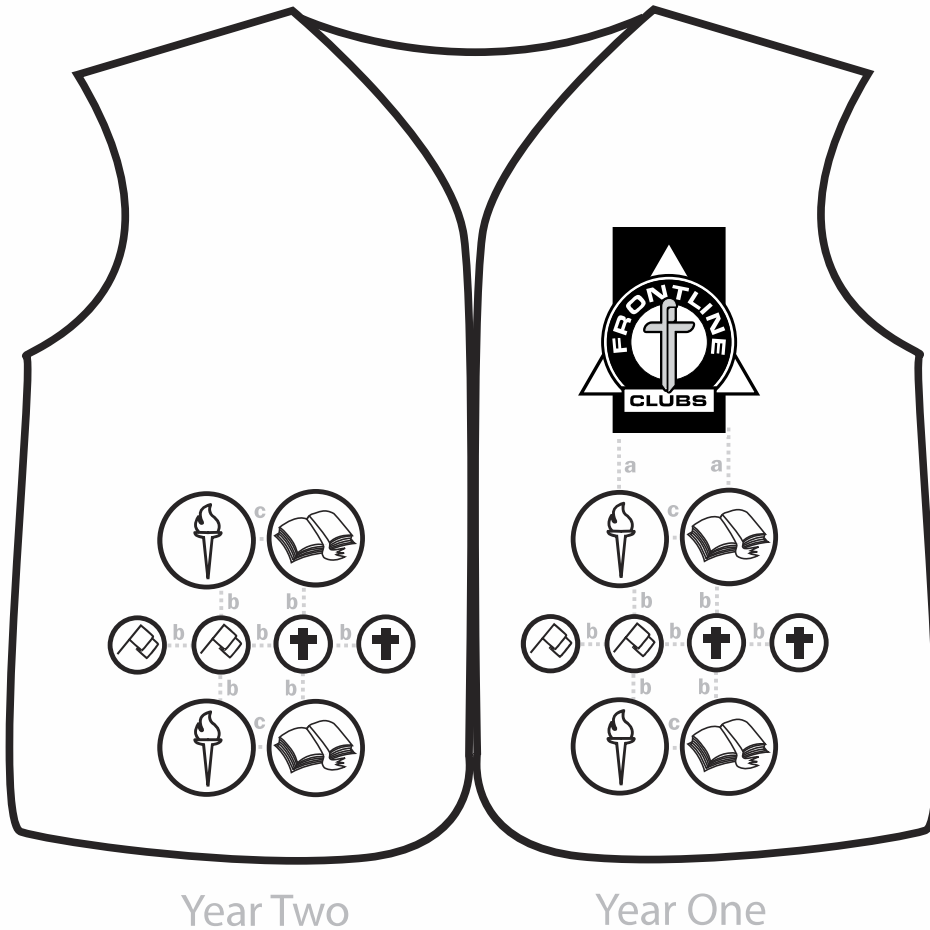

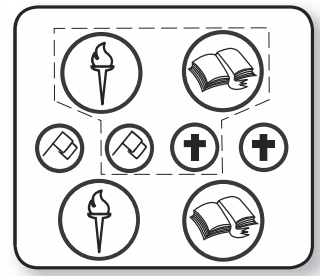

## Attaching Award Patches

Please note that first year clubbers (3 and 4 year olds not graduating to K5/Marchers in the fall) should display their awards on the LEFT side of their vests. Second year clubbers (4 year olds graduating to Marchers in the fall) should display their awards on the RIGHT side of their vests. All patches should be sewn in place.

To align the awards on the right side of the vest (Year Two): Measure from the top Faithfulness patch (torch) on the Year One side of the vest to the binding at the center of the vest (this will be different depending on the vest size). Place the Bible Memory patch the same distance from the binding on the Year Two side. Align the other patches as indicated on the diagram above.

\*The flagpole on the Attendance patch should be at a 45° angle.



Patches shown within the dotted lines above are first semester awards.

# GETTING STARTED

All Christians, young and old, grow in their Christian lives by reading their Bibles and praying every day. One of the goals of FrontLine Clubs is to help each clubber develop a daily habit of Bible study and prayer. The Club Journals are designed to help accomplish this goal.

Each Club Journal is divided into fifteen weeks of material. Each week of material includes a title page, five daily pages, and a Duty Checklist page.

## **Title Page**

---

The Title Page for each week includes the lesson number, lesson name, memory passage for the week, and a service assignment. The memory passage will be referred to daily and must be memorized before the next club meeting in order for your child to receive his Bible Memory Award. The Barracks Duty must also be done sometime before the next club meeting. If the Barracks Duty given is not appropriate for your child, you may feel free to substitute something else in its place. This box must be signed by the parent in order for the clubber to receive credit for having done the assignment.

## **Daily Pages**

---

Each week includes five daily assignments. The assignments must be done on different days of the week in order for the clubber to earn credit for doing them. Each assignment includes instructions for memorizing the memory passage, a variety of activities to reinforce and teach the weekly lesson, and a reminder to spend time in prayer. At the end of each daily assignment is a box for the parent to sign and date, confirming that the clubber has completed the work. All five pages should be signed in order for your child to receive his Faithfulness Award.

## **Duty Checklist Page**

---

The Duty Checklist at the end of each week provides a place for the club leader to record what was accomplished by the clubber that week. There is also space to record a Field Duty, if one was completed.

4. Color the scout tools below. Circle the tool that a FrontLine Scout uses to learn about God.



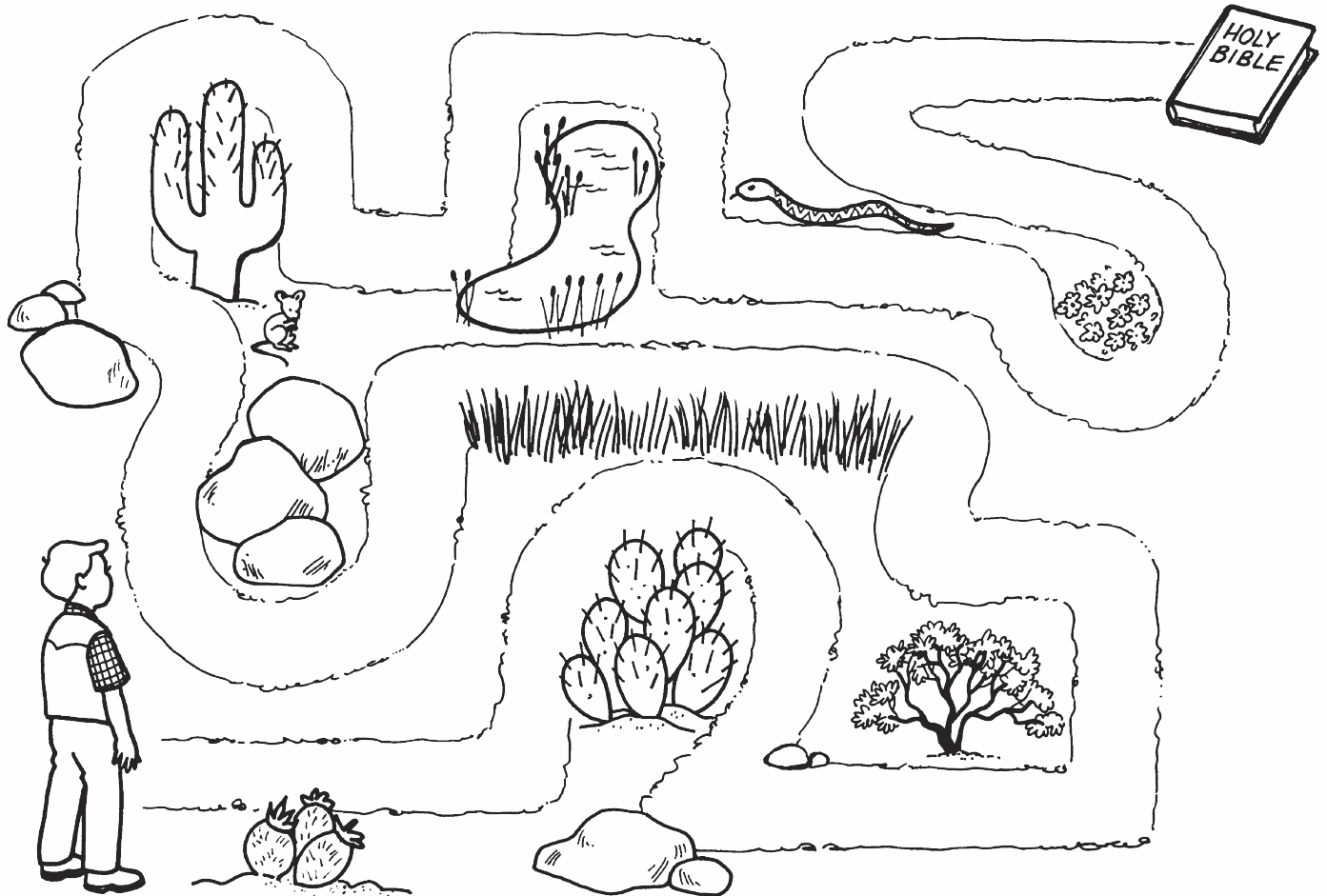

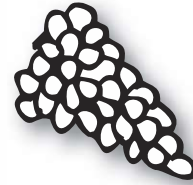

3. Color the picture of the scouts bringing back food from the land of Canaan.

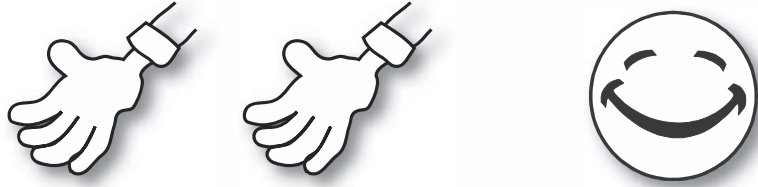

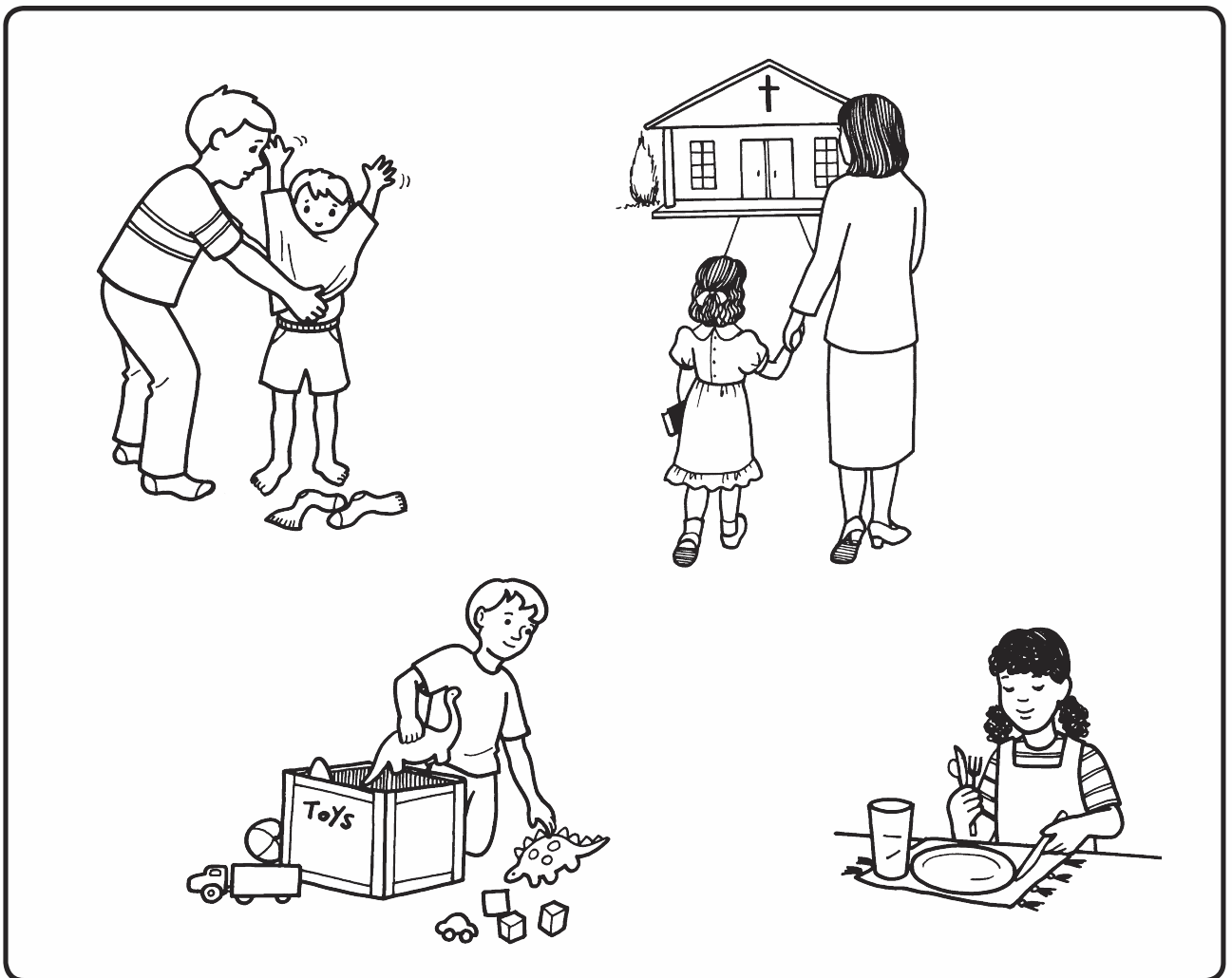
