PRESCHOOL

The preschool provides a variety of classes for children ages 2 to 5 years old. Two, three, four and five day programs are available. Classes begin at 9:15 a.m. and generally end at 1:15 p.m. Families provide a nut-free snack and lunch each day.

PARENTS' DAY OUT

The PDO provides loving care to children ages toddlers to 2 years. Young children have the opportunity of relating to each other and experiencing developmental activities. The program is one or two days per week from 9:15 am-1:15 pm. Parents provide a nut-free snack and lunch.

HISTORY/PHILOSOPHY

The Westover Baptist Preschool and Parents' Day Out began as a cooperative service founded by the Baptist Women's Missionary Union in 1971 as a way of providing healthy social and learning activities for their children. The women quickly realized that they had a mission in their own Arlington neighborhood community. The mission remains the same today: to provide for the social, cognitive, physical, emotional, and spiritual growth of children in an atmosphere of love and acceptance for all. Preschoolers learn about their world through play, exploration, and interaction with others.

RELIGIOUS PERSPECTIVE

Spiritual growth is largely sensed in very young children and is affected by the type of care and nurture surrounding children. The preschool strives to provide an atmosphere of love and acceptance for all children. They are taught to pause a moment each day before snack or lunch and thank God for food and family/friends. A monthly chapel time for the older preschool children provides lessons of learning and wisdom gleaned from the Judeo-Christian heritage in an easily understood format. Parents are welcome to attend chapel time. All children, regardless of race, religion, or ethnic background, are welcome at Westover Baptist Preschool.

ADMINISTRATION/LICENSING

Westover Baptist Church provides oversight of the Preschool through a committee composed of the pastor, church members, and the preschool director. The committee offers guidance in finances, the use of building/grounds, and policies. Westover Baptist Preschool and Parents' Day Out Program operates under the Religious Exemption program under the auspices of Arlington County and the Commonwealth of Virginia.

APPLICATION TO WESTOVER

All classes operate September through early June. Enrollment begins in January with currently enrolled children. Preference is then given to church members, siblings of currently enrolled children, children on our waiting list and then to the community. **To be placed on the waiting list, the completed form and \$25.00 fee (nonrefundable) must be received by the pre-school office.** Once on the list, the child will remain on the list for one year. Please email your

application to preschool@westoverbaptist.org, mail it or stop by the preschool to hand deliver.

- Threes: 2 or 3 days
- Twos: 2 or 3 days

- Toddlers: 1 or 2 days
