

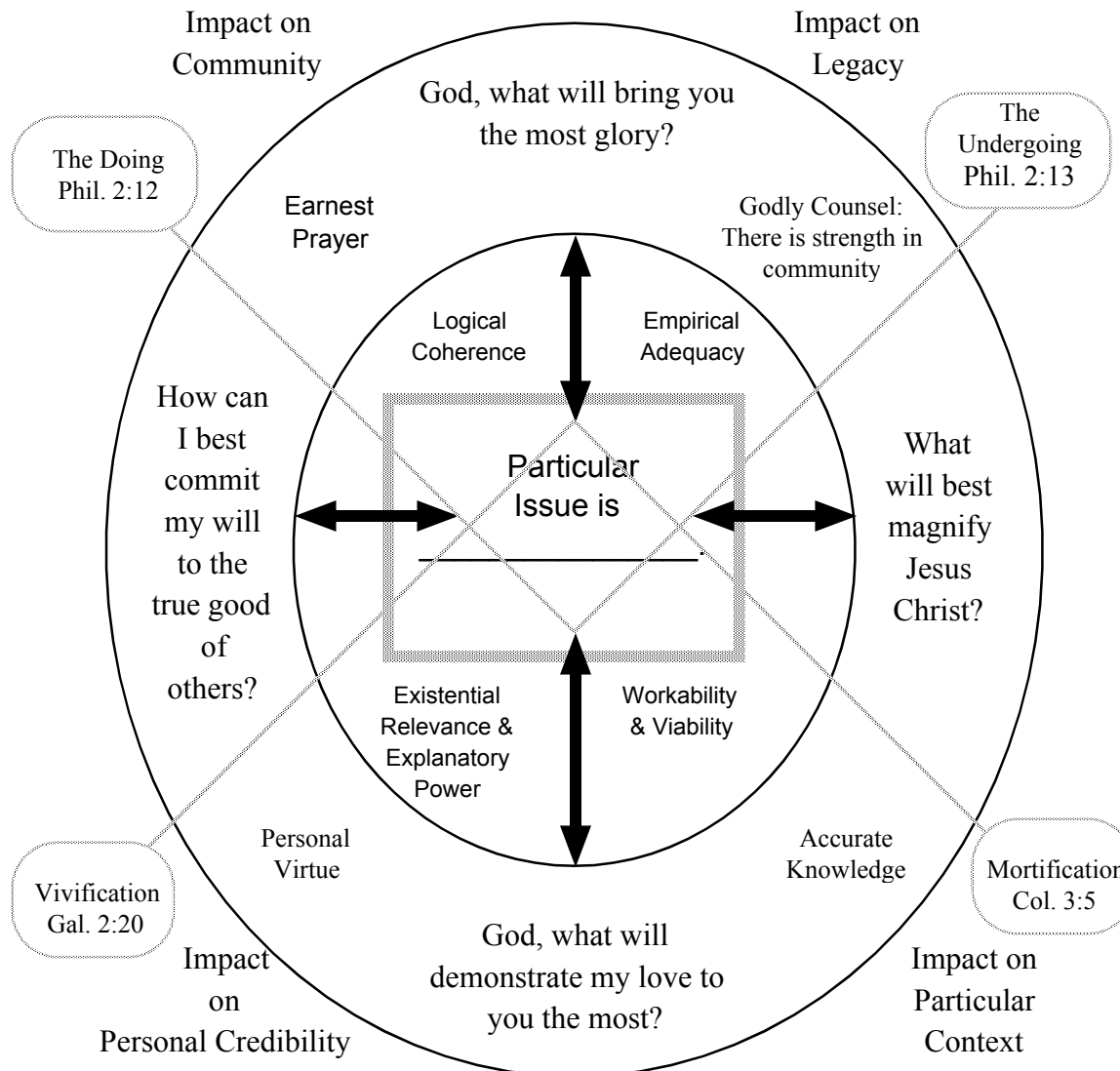

Biblical Worldview Foundation: A biblical worldview is comprised of biblical, systematic theology that not only best and coherently answers the ultimate questions of life (e.g., origin, meaning, identity, morality, & destiny), but is also (1) logically coherent, (2) empirically adequate, (3) existentially relevant, (4) explanatory powers, (5) viable, (6) workable, and possesses the most God-honoring (7) ethical and aesthetic virtues, values, duties, & accountability.
