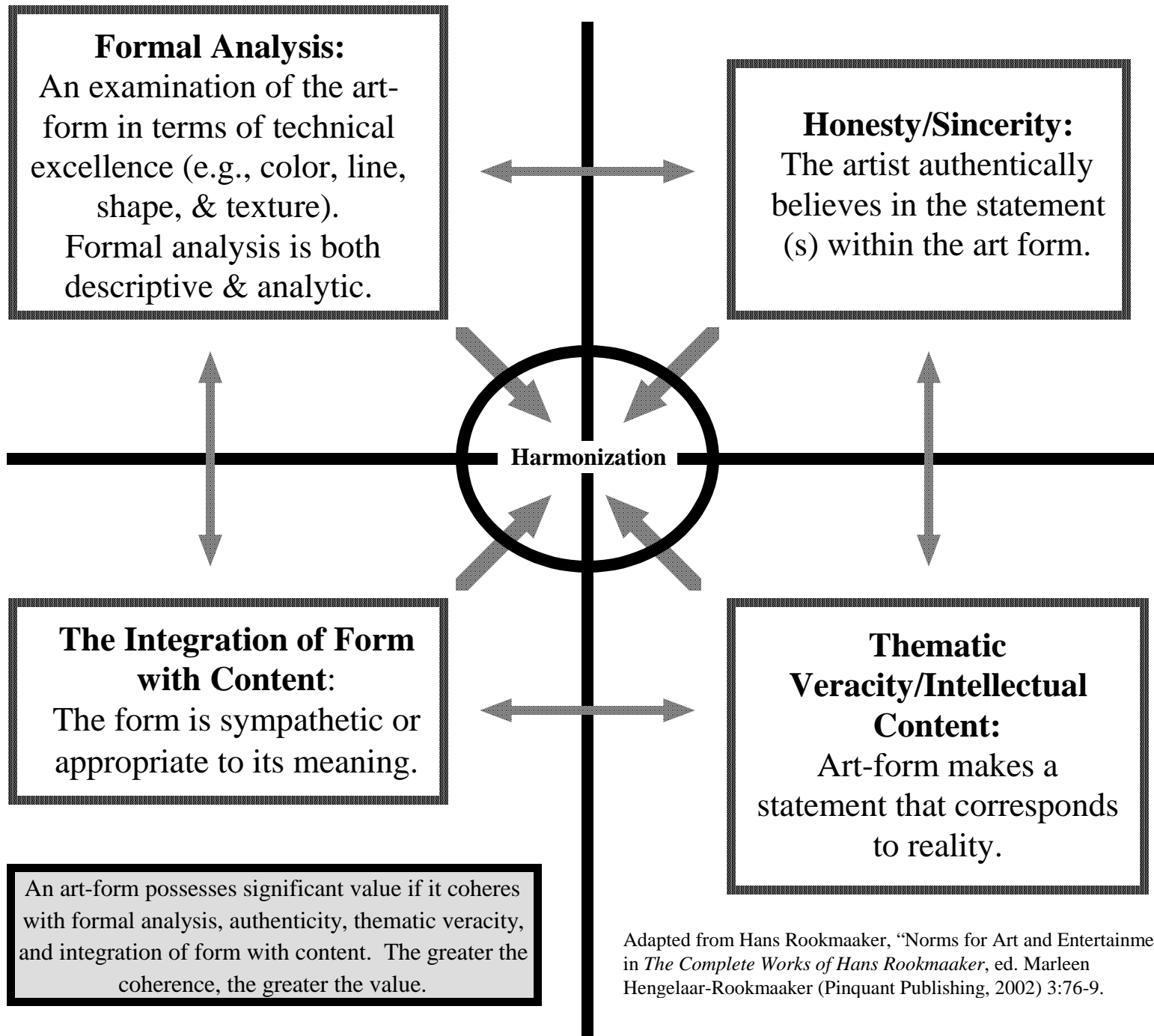


What Possesses Aesthetic Value: A Coherent Approach:

This approach incorporates all four judgments into an integrated coherent model. The *greater the harmonization between the four judgments*, the more valuable is the art-form. This approach may be substantiated in at least two different ways:

First, art-forms which have stood the test of time have greater harmonization of these four values.

And second, each of these values are empirically evident cross-culturally; they are universal judgments.
