Secondly, as faithful Christians, we are winners because we miss eternal torment in a burning hell. The apostle Paul declared, "And to you that are afflicted rest with us, at the revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven with the angels of his power in flaming fire, rendering vengeance to them that know not God, and to them that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus: who shall suffer punishment, even eternal destruction from the face of the Lord and from the glory of his might" (2 *The. 1:7-9*). We would be the worst of all losers if we had to spend an eternity in hell. My friends if we do not obey the Gospel we are losers!

Thirdly, as faithful Christians, we are winners because we have heaven as a reward. Jesus told us that He has to the Father where there are many mansions and is preparing us a place (*Jn. 14:1-3*). Jesus, in describing the dwelling place of God as mansions, gives us an idea of the glorious and beautiful place heaven must be. The winner of the Super Bowl gets rings, the winner of a race gets a trophy, winners over an illness receive good health; but, the one who obeys God's will is the greatest winner of all – a home in heaven! It is easy to see why the faithful Christian is the greatest winner of all.

The trouble with the world today is that they are trying to be winners of everything under the sun – except for what is really important and eternal – the crown of glory that awaits the faithful in heaven. Focusing on trying to be winners in this life will cause us to be losers in the next life.

"Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain it. Every athlete exercises self-control in all things. They do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable" (1 *Cor. 9:24-25; ESV*)
