and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd" (*Jn. 10:16*). Jesus has only one flock. Is it any wonder then that the psalmist declared, "The Lord is my shepherd" (*Psa. 23:1*)?

JESUS IS THE DOOR. Our Lord proclaimed, "I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture" (*Jn. 10:9*). Jesus is that door through which we must travel to get to the desired destination – heaven. If we try to enter in through another door we would not be in the fold of Christ, we will not feed in heaven's pasture; and would be considered a thief and a robber (*Jn. 10:1*). Paul said, "For through him [Christ] we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father" (*Eph. 2:18*). There is no entrance into heaven than through Jesus. Jesus is the door that leads to eternal life.

JESUS IS OUR HIGH PRIEST. The Hebrews writer informs us, "Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus" (*Heb. 3:1*). In the Law of Moses it was the duty if the High Priest to make intercession to God on behalf of the people. The High Priest entered the Holy of Holies once a year to make sacrifice for the sins of the people. Now Jesus, as our High Priest, makes intercession to God on our behalf. In the time of the Law of Moses on the High Priest was allowed to enter the Most Holy Place, but now Christ, as our High Priest, has torn down the veil that separated the Holy of Holies from the Holy Place. Symbolically, the Holy of Holies represents heaven and Christ made it possible for us to enter the Holy of Holies from the Holy Place (the church). Only the priests were allowed to enter the Holy Place – today Christians are the priests of God (*1 Pt. 2:9*). Thus, Christ had made it possible for every Christian to enter heaven. As our High Priest Jesus gives us access to the Father.
