DO YOU HAVE TIME?

There is an old worn out excuse many use time and time again to justify their lack of daily Bible reading. The excuse sounds something like this: "I just can't seem to find the time to read my Bible." Those who would use a lack of time as an excuse, a lame excuse I might add, should consider the following. It takes approximately 70 hours and 40 minutes to read the Bible through aloud. An average reader can read the Old Testament in 52 hours and 20 minutes. The New Testament book that takes the longest to read is Luke – 2 hours and 43 minutes. The book of Psalms takes the longest to read in the Old Testament – 4 hours and 28 minutes.

So you say you do not have time to read your Bible? That is very strange in light of the following statistics. Each and every day contains 24 hours or 1,440 minutes. A week contains 168 hours or 10,080 minutes. Any thirty-day month contains 720 hours or, 43,200 minutes. Every year contains 8,760 hours, or 525,800 minutes.

Think about it – just 12 minutes a day! Don't you think that you could spend 12 minutes a day reading the Book the Almighty so lovingly provided us? If we were to read about 35 minutes a day, we would be able to read the Bible through 3 times in a year! Surely we can spend 35 minutes a day reading the word of God – especially when you consider that there are 1,440 minutes in a day!

So you say you do not have time to read the Bible? Who are you trying to fool? Isn't it true we always seem to make time for what we really want to do? If you will truly be honest with yourself, you do not have time to read your Bible because you really do not want to read the word of God. If we do not love to read the word of God, can we truly love God? The Psalmist said, "O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day" (Psa. 119:97).

We must read our Bible daily, and see that our children do as well – for we are on a spiritual journey. On this journey we must constantly review the road map (the Bible), for if we refuse – we will be lost along the way. Beloved, the Bible directs out paths, it warns us of dangerous roads ahead, it guides us around difficult obstacles, and it helps us to keep good sense of ⇨
