WHAT ONE MAY EXPECT OF THE PREACHER

To preach the word (*1 Tim. 4:2*). This is his first and foremost responsibility.

To be a good example and keep his life pure (*1 Tim. 4:12*) – he lives in a fish bowl and everything he does leaves the church's imprint.
His counsel when there is a problem. He will use the word of God in this regard (*2 Pt. 1:3*).
