## FOUR WAYS PEOPLE REACT TO A SERMON

Whenever a gospel preacher stands in a pulpit to proclaim God's word to his audience, there will usually be four ways in which the hearers will respond to the message. Consider the following ways in which Christians may react to a sermon on not forsaking the assembly of the saints.

One Christians may say, "I do not forsake the assembly, but I appreciate you reminding me of this need." This reaction is given by one who never forsakes the assembly, if it is in his power to do so, but still loves to hear the old old story. Some, no matter how many times over the years they have heard a sermon on a given topic, still like to hear the story told. "O how love I thy law! It is my meditation all the day" (*Psa. 119:97*).

Another Christian may say, "I have been forsaking the assembly and I appreciate you pointing that out to me." This reaction is given by one who allows the message to affect their lives, and who wants to do better and will do better. This is the type of Christian who wants to be told when he is wrong, so that he can transform his life so as to be pleasing to God. "Unless thy law had been my delights, I should have perished in my afflictions. I will never forget thy precepts: for with them thou hast quickened me" (*Psa. 119:92-93*).

Still another Christian may say, "I know what you said is true – but..." This may be that Christian who hears the message but does not allow it to affect his life. This is a Christian who knows he is wrong, who knows he needs to do better, and yet, there is no change for the better. Some like to refer to this type of person as a "milquetoast" Christian – without stability or unassertive. "For is any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was" (*Jam. 1:23-24*).

The final type of reaction to a sermon may be said in this way, "All that preacher knows how to do is preach negative sermons. Doesn't he know how to encourage?" It is strange how one will consider a sermon encouraging while another will consider the same sermon as negative. Usually one who considers a sermon to be negative has just had his "toes stepped on" and does not like it. This is the type of person who says, "Preach what I want to hear and not what I need." Sadly, too many are like those of Jeremiah's day who when the word of God was spoken said, "We will not walk therein" (*Jer. 6:16*).
