JOYFUL STRENGTH

"Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto him for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye grieved; for the joy of Jehovah is your strength" (*Neh. 8:10*). The greatest strength we can know is the strength of joy in God's goodness. Indeed, the very powers of hell tremble before any person whose strength is the true joy of the Lord. And when we neglect to grow strong in this way, every other strength is but weakness. Without joy, our "strength" is easily broken. Without this joy we are depressed. Without this joy there is no true happiness.

Consider the source of Jesus' own strength. Only hours before He allowed Himself to be crucified, Jesus said to His disciples, "I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now" (*Jn. 16:22*). He prayed to God, "But now I come to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy made full in themselves" (*Jn. 17:13*). ⇨

John's account says that when the mob arrived to take Him, "Jesus therefore, knowing all things that would come upon Him, went forward and said to them, 'Whom are you seeking?' They answered Him, 'Jesus of Nazareth' . . . Now when He said to them, 'I am He,' they drew back and fell to the ground" (*Jn. 18:4-6*).

All the massed forces of evil in that hour of darkness had nothing with which to breach the fortress of joy within this great heart. Consequently, we are told to look "unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God" (*Heb. 12:2*). For nothing less than the joy set before Him, our Lord endured!

In the song that followed Israel's crossing of the Red Sea, Moses sang, "The Lord is my strength and song, and He has become my salvation; He is my God, and I will praise Him; my father's God, and I will exalt Him" (*Ex. 15:2*). The Lord is both our strength and our song. When God is our strength and our joy He is our song? When we have grown honestly eager to bring glory to God and when showing gratitude to Him has become our greatest joy, then we will have grown "strong" in the highest and finest sense of that wonderful word "joy."

Joy feels no burden, thinks nothing of trouble, attempts what is above its strength, and pleads no excuse of impossibility. Joy therefore enables us to stand and will not allow us to faint and lie down to difficulties
