THOSE NOBLE BEREANS

"Now these were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of the mind, examining the Scriptures daily, whether these things were so." (*Acts 17:11*). Blessed we would be, if we had more in the church today who were of like mind with the Bereans! The Christians in Berea were praised through the pen of inspiration for their open mindedness, their diligent study habits, and their desire that truth always prevails. These are the same qualities that every Christian should possess today – the qualities needed to make the church strong and pure.

Luke informs us that the Bereans "received the word with all readiness of mind." They had a willingness to hear, to be instructed, and to receive the truth of God's word. Without this willingness of mind, the Bereans could not have had the others qualities for which they were praised. We need to cultivate the same mind – a mind willing to be molded by the word of God. The Psalmist declared, "Teach me, O Jehovah, the way of thy statutes; And I shall keep it unto the end. Give me understanding, and I shall keep thy law; Yea, I shall observe it with my whole heart" (*Psa. 119:33-34*). This attitude stems from the desire to "love Jehovah thy God with all they heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might" (*Deut. 6:5*).

Secondly, the Bereans were praised for their efforts in "examining the scriptures daily." This they did because they loved the One from whom it was sent. If we truly love God we will read, study, and examine His words. The apostle Paul commanded, "Give diligence [study - KJV] to present thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, handling aright to word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15). Paul further instructed "to give heed to reading, to exhortation, to teaching" (1 Tim. 4:13). Perhaps the greatest reason for studying the Scriptures is that we will be judged by them (Jn. 12:48).

Thirdly, Luke informs us the reason the Bereans studied the Scriptures daily and that was to see "whether these things were so," that is, to ascertain if what they were being taught was truly from the word of God. And who were the Bereans checking out? The apostle Paul! They cared more for the truth of God's word than any man - the same must be true of us. They knew that they could and must be right. "And ye shall know they truth, and the truth shall make you free" (Jn. 8:32). We must be concerned about the truth and make sure we are being taught the truth. The only way this can be done is by examining the Scripture.

"Beloved, believe not every spirit, but prove [test] the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets are gone out into the world" (1 Jn. 4:1). "Speak thou the things which befit the sound doctrine" (Tit. 2:1).

May we all be as those noble Bereans!
