What should be the Christian's response? What would Jesus do? Was Jesus Politically Correct? Should we be Politically Correct? Jesus was not Politically Correct. One can easily see this by viewing some of His responses to the Pharisees of His day. Jesus called the Pharisees "hypocrites" (*Mt. 23:13*), "blind guides" (*Mt. 23:16*), "whited sepulchers...full of dead men's bones" (*Mt. 23:27*), and "off spring of vipers" (*Mt. 23:33*). Does this sound Politically Correct? No! Jesus was condemning sin in the most forceful way. Why? Because our Lord "came to seek and save that which was lost" (*Lk. 19:10*).

One of the attributes of Jesus that many have difficulty with is His boldness in addressing and correcting error. Many find it hard to believe that Jesus would actually confront people and tell they are wrong - and then tell them the correct view. This type of action goes against the Political Correctness culture. Most of the world has a pluralistic attitude, sometimes referred to as multiculturalism. This is the view that all cultures regardless of their moral and religious views are equally valid. The world, as a whole, believes that Jesus was not judgmental of others' views and practices, and would never embarrass anyone suggesting they had the wrong view on a matter. But this is not the Jesus of the Bible. Jesus corrected error, engaged in debate, and participated in logical argument setting forth truth and condemning error.

Friends, we can never lead the lost to Christ while being Politically Correct. Politically Correctness is not correct - in reality it is hateful. But let's always be careful to speak the truth in love (*Eph. 4:15*).
