"One generation goeth, and another generation cometh...There is no remembrance of the former generations; neither shall there be any remembrance of the latter generations that are to come, among those that shall come after" (*Eccl. 1:4,11*).

In this world, we are meant to be replaced. Even as great a man as David was, no greater thing could be said of him than this: "For David, after he had in his own generation served the counsel of God, fell asleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and saw corruption" (*Acts 13:36*). In the chain of generations, his work was that of just one link.

But if our work is that of one link, we ought to want it to be the best link possible. Having done our part, we will be replaced (and forgotten by those who replace us), but mighty consequences hinge on whether we do our part well — while we still live. While we are alive let us be an epistle written in the hearts of others and read of all men (*2 Cor. 3:2*). May our link in life's chain be salt and light to the world. "Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost its savor, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out and trodden under foot of men. Ye are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do *men* light a lamp, and put it under the bushel, but on the stand; and it shineth unto all that are in the house. Even so let your light shine before men; that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven" (*Mt. 5:13-16*).
