LOVE IS... #2

Love is fervent. The apostle Peter proclaimed, "Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently" (*1 Pt. 1:22*). Our love for our brethren and fellowman must be diligent, zealous, and boiling over. Love must not be taken lightly.

Love is keeping the commands of God. "By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments" (*1 Jn. 5:2*). We cannot truly love one another if we will not keep the commands of God. The liberals talk so much about love, but they don't love God, their brethren, or their fellowman, if they do not stay true to the Book. That is why Jesus said, "If ye love me, keep my commandments" (*Jn. 14:15*).
