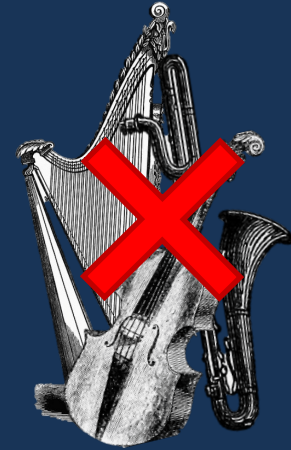
WORSHIP

SINGING

- **Teaching** – instruction, instill doctrine
 - **Admonishing** – put in mind, warning
 - **Praising** – to extol, honor, commend
 - **Speaking** – to utter words, proclaim
 - **Singing** – verbal vocal music, praise
 - **Giving Thanks** – gratitude or agreement
- (Eph. 5:18-21; Col. 3:15-17; Heb. 13:15)
