

October 2020: Prayer Focus

“Father, How Can I Hear You?”

Instructions: Meditate and be changed daily using the assigned Scripture and Thought. Build your prayer life by using the Thought from the previous week (s) as well as the current week.

“My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me”

John 10:27 (KJV)

Week 1: (October 1st - October 8th)

Jeremiah 29:13 New King James Version (NKJV)

13)“And you will seek for Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.”

Thought: Ask yourself- Do you expect to hear from God? So, to hear Him, you have to tune in and listen carefully. Another way to describe the way we hear God’s voice is through an inward witness.

Week 2: (October 9th- October 15th)

John 10: 4-5 The Passion Translation (TPT)

4)“And when he has brought out all his sheep, he walks ahead of them and they will follow him, for they are familiar with his voice. 5)But they will run away from strangers and never follow them because they know it’s the voice of a stranger.”

Thought: He teaches us how to be led by the Spirit. But to reach a level of intimacy with God where we hear His voice and are launched into new places in the spirit, obedience must become a non-negotiable in our lives.

Week 3: (October 16th - October 22nd)

Proverbs 2:1-5 New American Standard Bible (NASB)

1)“My son, if you will receive my words And treasure my commandments within you, 2)Make your ear attentive to wisdom; 3)For if you cry for discernment, Lift your voice for understanding; 4)If you seek her as silver And search for her as for hidden treasures; 5)Then you will discern the fear of the Lord And discover the knowledge of God.”

Thought: If you want to get to a place where you do not have to wonder whose voice you are hearing—yours, the devil’s or God’s—you need to spend time with the Lord. The more time you spend with Him, the more certain you will become about hearing God’s voice. It is not just time talking to Him, though. We learn His voice when we listen to His voice.

Week 4: (October 23rd - October 31st)

2 Timothy 3:16 Amplified (AMP)

16) "All Scripture is God-breathed [given by divine inspiration] and is profitable for instruction, for conviction [of sin], for correction [of error and restoration to obedience], for training in righteousness [learning to live in conformity to God's will, both publicly and privately---behaving honorably with personal integrity and moral courage];

Thought: One sure way to know if you are hearing God's voice is to line up what you hear against the Word of God. God will never tell you to do, think or say anything contrary to His Word. God always agrees with His written Word, and His Word always agrees with Him.

The best part about hearing God's Voice:

You will not just avoid counterfeit voices—you will be given access to secrets and revelation knowledge that will make you the head and not the tail (Deuteronomy 28:13). In Jeremiah 33:3, He says, "Call to Me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things, which you do not know" (NASB). All you have to do is pursue a life in which you hear the voice of God, heed it, and walk into a victory you never thought possible.

When you check your receiver, find His frequency, learn to discern His voice, and line up what you hear with His Word—hearing God's voice will not be an occasional event, but a lifestyle. And when someone asks you, "What is the Spirit of God telling you today?" you will not hesitate for a moment.

You will know exactly what to say.
