### **RECONCILING IN CHRIST—UPDATE**

### In January our congregation voted to become a Reconciling in Christ congregation and adopted the following RIC affirmation:

"At Gloria Dei Lutheran Church we welcome all who are seeking God's love and grace. We welcome all because God welcomes all, regardless of race or culture, sexual orientation, gender identity, or relationship status. We welcome all without regard to the social, cultural or economic circumstances that too often divide us. Our unity is in Christ in whom we are all made new."

### We base this affirmation on the following scripture:

"So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us." 2 Corinthians 5:17-19.

### **Activities completed:**

Reconciling Works: Reconciling Works – Lutherans for Full Participation notified of our decision to become an RIC congregation. Our church is now included in the list of Lutheran churches in the Long Beach area as an RIC congregation. Anyone looking for an RIC congregation will be able to find our church using the Reconciling Works Web site and searching the Long Beach area.

### Gloria Dei's Web site updated:

A new tab on the Gloria Dei Website entitled "Reconciling" includes the affirmation noted above plus a link to the Web site for Reconciling in Christ – Lutherans for Full Participation and a link to the ELCA's statement on human sexuality. Also included on this page is our congregation's mission statement.

RIC logo added to Gloria Dei's Web site: The RIC logo has been added to 'home' page of the church's Web site and is linked to the site's 'Reconciling' page. Mission Statement/Affirmation: The church's mission statement and Reconciling in Christ affirmation are posted in the Narthex.

### RIC Affirmation in the Service Bulletin:

Our Reconciling in Christ affirmation has been added to our Sunday service bulletins.

### Next steps:

RIC logo/'tag' line: The Reconciling in Christ logo and the text "A Reconciling in Christ Congregation" will be included in our Sunday service bulletins and added to the church's stationary. Advertising: Advertisements for Gloria Dei will include "A Reconciling in Christ Congregation".

### **CONGREGATION UPDATE**

Our Church Council met last on June the 6<sup>th</sup>, with a full Agenda. As always, Pastor Beckham opened the meeting with prayer. Our devotional assignment was to consider and rate the statement, "The congregation is always ready to try something new". The consensus was to rate our congregation between "somewhat" and "very well".

Pastor Beckham offered Synod Assembly highlights and brought us current on those of concern. Pulpit supply during his vacation will be **Pastors Laurie Arroyo and David Hodgson.** 

The discussion of *Video Monitors* was introduced with motion to postpone until September's meeting. The kitchen remodel had met a stalemate due to lack of funds for bids submitted and referred back to **Karen Como** and her committee for possible options to consider. She will research and meet with the committee in August and present their findings to Council in September.

Our faithful treasurer **Gary Bockman** reported a shortage to the spending plan of \$11,250. Discussion to revise the 2016 spending plan was considered but the decision was to stay as planned, as many gift at year end. The annual internal audit has been completed by David Kahakauwila and Dondi Buchrucker and sent to our Synod office.
