SUBJECT: Safety Brief

1. Vary routes of travel to and from hotels, bus stops and other destination points.
2. Avoid displaying clothing and carry bags that readily identify you as an American.
3. Watch for and report suspicious behavior to the nearest authorities.
4. Go immediately to a police station, military facility or well-lit area if you believe you are being followed.
5. Avoid public mass gathering areas.
6. Be aware of your surroundings at all times.
7. Do not post geo-tagging while on your trip nor post pictures to social media until after your return.
8. Exercise caution when withdrawing money from Automatic Teller machines (ATMs). Be alert for potential distraction measures and ATMs that appear to be tampered with.
9. Avoid displaying flashy or large quantities of jewelry.
10. Do not display large quantities of cash while in public settings.
11. Avoid walking close to street edges where moped riders can pass by and snatch carry bags and ride away.
12. Avoid carrying all ID cards and cash in one location (wallet/purse). Considering placing an ID with cash in a separate location. In the event of a loss or stolen wallet/purse you'll still have an ID and cash to get home with.
13. Be cautious of overly friendly strangers who seem extremely interested in you, your family or your work.

- 14. Do not accept drinks from strangers or leave your drink unattended in public setting.
- 15. Exercise the buddy system whenever possible.
- 16. Maintain your individual integrity by not overly indulging in intoxication liquors.
- 17. If traveling by vehicle, keep windows up and doors locked in congested and highly populated areas.
- 18. Inspect your vehicle for tampering after its been unattended for any length of time.
- 19. Park in well lighted areas, preferably where your vehicle is monitored by a CCTV system.
- 20. Avoid leaving valuables in hotel rooms. Use rooms safes whenever available.
- 21. Visit travel.state.gov prior to departing on travel to review the most recent safety and security information pertaining to your destination point.
