Passport & Visa Requirements when traveling

Passports

When travelling outside of the UK you must make sure you have the required documents to travel. Most companies now require you to have a passport to travel; this includes active duty military members who are usually exempt from travelling with a passport. There are several different types of passports:

Blue Tourist Passport

This passport is your personal property and can be used to travel anywhere in the world, certain countries may require you to also have a visa to enter.

Blue No-Fee Passport

This passport is the passport that is issued by the Dept of State in conjunction with an overseas assignment, it is issued free as part of the PCS process, this is the passport that a majority of dependents will have their UK Visa in and always contains a statement in the back that states that the passport is valid only for use in conjunction with the bearers residence abroad as a dependent of an active duty person outside of the United States. This passport is designed to get the bearer from the US to the country they are assigned to only, not for leisure travel.

Maroon Official Passport

This passport is issued to active duty members and is to be used ONLY in conjunction with TDY travel orders.
