Welcome

Budgewoi Football Club (BFC) welcomes you to the up and coming 2020 football season, commencing this April. The following information has been put together to make your footballing experience at our club organised and enjoyable. Please take your time to read through the information thoroughly. BFC is a community based club that provides a fun, safe environment for all committee, coaches, managers, players and supporters.

Online registrations are now OPEN, please register promptly as spots are not guaranteed.

This is a 'first in best dressed' scenario. Once an age group becomes full, the online system will NOT accept your registration. Instead, it will convert you over to our clubs waiting list.

Please be mindful, that age groups can fill VERY FAST! Only fully registered and **PAID** players will be allocated spots in teams.

Central Coast Football has advised that they will continue with the "cashless referee structure". All referees will continue to be paid by CCF and not cash on the day at the clubs. Therefore we have again incorporated referee and cadet referee fees in everyone's player registrations.

Please note the referee fees charged are on a 75% ratio of referee availability, there will still be some games that we are not allocated a referee or cadet referee.

Important Notice

To become a registered player and therefore eligible to play for BFC;

FULL PAYMENT must have been received and processed

BFC reserve the right to decline any player's application

A successful Club can only be run with the support of its families and players. Our teams will be 'rostered' to help; field setting up/packing away, official table and canteen/BBQ. This includes Junior's on Saturday's and Senior's on Sunday's.

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What does BSC and BFC Mean?

Budgewoi Soccer Club (BSC) is the licensed premises here at Millington Way, Buff Point. It is 1 of 8 clubs under the Wyong Rugby League Club Group (WRLCG). Budgewoi Football Club (BFC) is the major affiliated sporting club of BSC.

Budgewoi Soccer Club Membership (WRLCG)

All senior players MUST become members of the licensed club along with a minimum of one (1) junior parent/guardian

Membership can be obtained at the BSC front reception or bar any time that the club is open. The cost is \$12.00 per year. This will provide you with club information and food and beverage discounts. It will also help management maintaining our fields and amenities to service our football community. Becoming a member is easy and can be done during opening hours (10am – late, 7 days a week).

- To register as an over 18 player, the above must be completed.
- To register as an under 18 player, the above must be completed by at least one (1) parent or guardian.

The FFA Online System www.playfootball.com.au

This online system is the official registration system throughout Australia. It is a 24/7 self-service system. To use the system every player will create an online account, if you are a previously registered player, please use your existing account. If you have forgotten your log-in details, then please follow the online prompts to retrieve them. This is the only way to registered. Registration forms do not get handed out to clubs anymore. The system is designed to be quick, easy and available 24/7.

Online Registration, Email and Phone Numbers

Please make sure that you submit your correct details as they will be passed over to your coach and committee for communication purposes. If your details change throughout the year, you can simply log back in to your FFA account and change your details.

Photos

Photos for your Registration ID are the responsibility of the individual and can be uploaded via your FFA account. Please follow the online instructions as to the type and size of the photo that is required.

ALL PLAYERS MUST UPLOAD NEW PHOTOS THIS YEAR. Please make sure that you have an appropriate passport style photo ready to upload (shoulder and head shot)

What is included in Registration?

- Juniors; jersey, socks and training ball.
(playing jersey will remain the property of the club).
- Seniors: jersey, socks, and each team receives a set of training balls.
(jersey and training balls will remain the property of the club).

Socks and balls will be handed out towards the start of the season in TEAM LOTS to each Coach or Manager.

\$100 ACTIVE KIDS REBATE

The NSW Government \$100 Active Kids Rebate will be available for eligible activities from 1 January 2020 for school children aged 4.5 years – 18 years.

To use the rebate for your football registration you must apply for your rebate voucher and unique code at Service NSW from 1st January 2020 (online or in person).

Extract from the government guidelines

How to apply and redeem vouchers.

There are four simple steps:

1. Visit <https://sport.nsw.gov.au/sectordevelopment/activekids> . Read the Guidelines and Fact Sheets to learn about the program.
2. Visit service.nsw.gov.au and create or login to your MyServiceNSW Account.
3. Complete an Active Kids application through your MyServiceNSW Account. You will receive a voucher with a unique ID number for each child you register (available to download, print and email).
4. Redeem your voucher: log onto myfootballclub.com.au. The NSW Government \$100.00 Active Kids Rebate is available now.

This is the only way to claim your discount code.

**Players must be registered prior to the introduction and allocation day to be allocated into teams.
Players not registered and paid may miss out on a team placement as additional players will only be taken if there are any vacancies in the Club for that age group.**

Trial Games at Budgewoi Football Club grounds will be on Saturday 14th and 21st March, times and details will be on website closer to dates.

Team Allocation

Although we do our best to accommodate all registered and paid players, sometimes unfortunately as team numbers are limited your child may miss out on a place even when registered in the system. We do our best to allocate numbers and close teams as they become full, in the unfortunate case that our numbers are not correct and a player is unable to be allocated into a team a full refund will be issued.

Grading

BFC believes that football is most enjoyable when players are challenged but not overwhelmed. With this in mind we try to place players into teams of similar ability and then place each team into a division that will make playing both challenging and enjoyable.

When deciding which team a player will be placed in, we consider last years' team performance, reports from coaches, performance on grading day/trial game days.
