The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, Wealden Leisure Ltd will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Wealden Leisure Ltd to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Wealden Leisure Ltd or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society. - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Wealden Leisure Ltd ask you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.



What is a Direct Debit?

A simple, safe and convenient banking service which enables you to authorise your Bank or Building Society to settle your accounts as and when they fall due.

Invitation to pay by direct debit

Direct Debiting is a simple, inexpensive and convenient way of paying all kinds of bills. freedom leisure invites you to sign an instruction to your Bank/Building Society authorising them to pay various amounts from your account at our request. This means that there will be no need for us to trouble you to sign a fresh authority whenever the amount changes, although you will receive advice of the amounts due on your bill/statement each year. No payments will be taken until you have been given 10 days notice of the amounts and due dates. Please see the guarantees set out overleaf.

When will your account be debited?

Direct Debit amounts will be debited from your account in accordance with the detail on your Season Ticket invoice.

Direct Debit information for you to keep

Your direct debit payments will be taken from your nominated Bank / Building Society account on the date specified on the confirmation invoice.
