**A**s I sit and ponder over the task that God, The Creator of this vast universe, has given to me, I find it to be somewhat overwhelming. The Apostle Paul in First Timothy 1:12 the Amplified version says: *I give thanks to Him who has granted me [the needed ] strength and made me able [for this], Christ Jesus and Lord, because He has judged and counted me faithful and trustworthy, appointed me to [this stewardship of] the ministry.*

To some, the responsibility of building what I am personally calling a village but others are saying a city, is a small thing. The “assignment” has grown three times already.

My assignment has to do with preparing a place so that peoples very lives can be improved, changed and upgraded. That hope can come into an area where there did not appear to be any. One of the amazing things about this is, I have to travel over seven thousand miles one way to see it and will probably never actually live in the village or city. I do anticipate short stays but it will be home for others. 1 Thess. 5:18 tells me **in**

**everything** to give thanks for this **is the will** of

God in Christ Jesus concerning you (me). I thank God.

In my thanks to God I am also thanking Him for you. God has used you (all that have supported this vision financially and prayerfully) to make the necessary provision available.

Your finances have gone to the changing of peoples lives.

*God has granted me the needed strength and made me able for this.*

For those reading this and saying ‘I am too old,’ I can’t do this ‘ or whatever the other excuses you are making, remember the Word of God says: ‘I can do **all** things through Christ who gives me the strength.

The hour is getting to be late and some of you my friends have been putting off getting started on your ‘assignment’. It just may be part of my assignment is to keep reminding you that there is work for you to do in God’s Kingdom. Yours may not be to go to Africa or some other foreign country, but rest assured there is an assignment with your name on it.

God may have assigned you to be the prayer covering for some missionary or the financial support. It may be to educate some child in a rural village on the other side of the world. For whatever reason you have given to The Father for not stepping up and taking your place, just remember, He gave it to you and He will grant unto you “the needed strength” to do the
