(Daniel 2:44) KJV

I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed. (Daniel 7:13-14) KJV

Nathanael acknowledged the King:

**Nathanael answered** and saith unto Him, **Rabbi, thou art the Son of God; thou art the King of Israel.** (John 1:49) KJV

And when He was come nigh, even now at the descent of the Mount of Olives, **the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen;**

Saying, **blessed be the King that cometh in the name of the LORD:** peace in heaven, and glory in the highest. (Luke 19:37-38) KJV

**On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the LORD.** (John 12:12-13) KJV



## **THE HOLY ONE OF THE LORD GOD**

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**And now, saith the LORD that formed me from the womb to be his servant,** to bring Jacob again to him, though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be glorious in the eyes of the LORD, and my God shall be my strength.

And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: **I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.**

Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, **Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee.**




