From the advice of the Salaf In warning against the people of innovations

And from Imaam Shafiee'a (rahimahullaah): that he saw people talking about philosophy. So he called out to them:

"Either you accompany us with good, or you leave (go away) from us."

The Imaam of Ahlus-Sunnah, Ahmad ibn Hanbal (rahimahullaah) said:

"Verily it is not befitting to seek anything regarding the matters of the religion; from the people of innovations and desires .

Verily in that (seeking assistance from them) is the worst harm to the religion." ²

And he (rahimahullaah) also said:

"Beware of innovation. All of it.

And do not consult even one of the people of innovations; in your religion." ³

Al-Imaam Abdurrahmaan al-Mahdee (rahimahullaah) said:

"Verily the worst of the people of desires are the people of Jahm (the Jahmiyyah). They intend to say: 'there's nothing above the sky.!'

I view that they should not be accepted for marriage nor inheritance." 4

Ayyoob al-Sakhtiyaanee (rahimahullaah) said:

"Verily the people of desires are people of misguidance.

And I do not see their abode except the Fire. " 6

And Aboo Yoosuf al-Qadhee (rahimahullaah) said:

" I do not pray behind a Jahmee , nor a Rafidhee or a Qadaree." 7

Aboo Muhammad Husayn al-Baghawee (rahimahullaah) said:

And al-Imaam Ismaa'eel as-Swaaboonee has reported in his outstanding book "Aqeedatul Salaf As-haabul Hadeeth"; The consensus of Ahlus Sunnah in the obligation of subduing the Ahlul Bid'ah, and humiliating them.

He (rahimahullaah) said:

"And this is the statement which has been established. This was their creed —all of them- they never differed in this. [meaning the creed of the scholars of hadeeth].

Rather they had complete agreement in it.

And they agreed upon that , and upon subduing the people of innovations , and humiliating them, and abandoning them, and exposing them, and staying away from them , and [also staying away] from those who accompany them and consult them.

And they [Ahlus Sunnah] seek closeness to Allaah by staying away and abandoning them [the Ahlul Bid'ah]."
