Youth Receive Powerful Insight at POPAPIC Regional Youth Summit



“I really enjoyed this Summit. I feel so blessed to have experienced this day and I will never forget it.”

These are only a couple of the unsolicited responses uttered from the delegates who attended the POPAPIC Regional Youth Summit this past summer held on the banks of the Mississippi River in historic Port Allen, Louisiana.

Some 120+ youth delegates, ages 10 to 21 representing various ministries, schools and colleges from the Southeast region of the great state of Louisiana, spent the day learning the principles of living out their purpose and unlocking their potential, enjoying praise and worship with local ministers of music, and having fun with their peers. Pastors, youth leaders and parents from those churches were on hand to serve at the Youth Summit.

POPAPIC’s Founder and President Kenneth R. Fabre’ said **“this Youth Summit has grown in participation and was truly a regional gathering of not only youth, but ministries, parents, pastors, and college students. There were at least ten (10)**



churches/ministries represented from at least seven (7) distinct parishes/counties in and around Louisiana.” It is the continuation of one of POPAPIC’s primary vision assignments, to minister the gospel of Jesus Christ to the younger generation and to teach them God’s principles of Leadership, Purpose and Potential. “

God gave Bro Ken this assignment and vision for this kind of ministry to youth years ago during an intense time of personal prayer and intercession through the following scripture:

“Before I formed thee in the belly, I knew thee; and, before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.” **Jeremiah 1:5**



Moreover, as recent as September, 2006 Bro Ken has been greatly inspired by a fresh revelation of the prophetic words proclaimed by the Word of God at **Psalms 22: 28, 30-31** concerning this very generation. **“Consequently, it is imperative that our children and youth of this day are given the opportunity to fully understand the concepts of Salvation in Christ... the true meaning of being a delegate and ambassador...the true biblical definition of what a Kingdom is...and how this all ties in by God, to their individual and personal Purpose for being born and the Potential that goes along with that Purpose.”**

One major blockage to this generation’s ability to grasp and understand these realities is secular music that promotes sexual promiscuity, murder, rape, lying, cheating and other vices. Bro Ken Fabre’, along with others again warned the delegates not to become “starstruck” with celebrities. They watched a videotaped message by a notable pastor preaching to youth about the dangers of filling their hearts and minds with negative messages from some music. That video message hit home with the delegates.



“I really liked the video presentation on the destructive influence of secular music. We received a better understanding of the negative impact, what it can and will have upon us,” said Taurcinesha White, age 15 from Baton Rouge Magnet High School and Abounding Love Ministries of Baton Rouge, LA.

Ministers of music **Stephen Street** from Chapel on the Campus Church of Baton Rouge, LA, **Unrika Ramsey** from Crossroads Family Worship Center of Ethel, LA, **Bro Ken Fabre’** and **Nakeytcia Sapp** age 15 (dance worshiper) of North Blvd. Macedonia Full Gospel Church of Baton Rouge and a student of Port Allen High School, led praise and worship, helping make this POPAPIC Regional Youth Summit a life-changing and life enhancing experience in the presence of Almighty God.

This Regional Summit was facilitated by **POPAPIC, INC.** in collaboration with numerous churches, ministries, and elected officials from our region who sent youth delegates and/or provided prayer and intercession for its God ordained success.
